Title: What Bibi Should Say

Shalom laYehudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim. It's the evening of the 4th day, *vav beAdar, tav-shin-ayin-beh, Parashas Taytsaveh*, the evening of the 3rd day, Tuesday, 24 February 2015, webcasting from the focus of world attention.

So Iran won the gold medal today for top story in Israel, specifically reports from Geneva that the P5+1 Western powers are on the verge of an agreement with Iran which poses a mortal danger to today's 6 million Jews living in their Promised Land that they brought back to life. Columnists were unanimous that this is not good news, big time.

Not that I am surprised. In the Passover story we read at the Seder every year, it says, "In every generation they rise up to put an end to us," and that is what is at the center, I think, of debate in Geneva; toying with that idea.

Of course, the manifest, surface discussion concerns the number of centrifuges Iran will be allowed to keep and for how many years, and the lifting of sanctions, but underneath here were the major post-Christian Europeans dealing respectfully and generously with Iran and its outspoken desire to destroy the state of the Jews, G-d forbid.

Today the coverage concerned the details of the outrageous sellout of Israel, but what I find most disgraceful was the initial decision by P5+1 countries to talk to Iran at all. Since 1979, Iran has proven itself to be a criminal, outlaw regime behind so much of the horror that Muslims have inflicted on the world, including assassinations and terror attacks in Europe and the role Iran played in 9-11.

It is to Europe's eternal shame, and no less America's that there are talks at all in the wake of the crimes this outlaw regime has committed and continues to commit.

I think all of the P5+1 have suffered terrorism with Iran's hidden hand in play. Eternal shame for that, when at any time all of them could have created a new alliance and on the same day declared war on Iran and given Iran an ultimatum to start dismantling its nuclear facilities or the alliance would not only destroy them but not end the war until the regime's leaders were captured or killed. As the U.S. removed the Japanese government in 1945 and ended the power of the emperor and helped install democracy, so the U.S. and allies should remove the government in Tehran and preside over the coming to power of a different kind of government not licking its lips over nuking Israel and threatening Europe and ultimately the U.S., Canada, Australia and all free men and women everywhere.

Herb Keinon in JPost today quoted an anonymous Israeli official who said, "In the beginning, the position of the world was that Iran should have no centrifuges. In 2006, there was a series of UN resolutions demanding that. Then, seven years later in 2013, the West began to buckle and agreed to let Iran had some symbolic retention of some centrifuges so as to help the Iranians save face. Now the figure is over six thousand centrifuges that will be permitted them, which, the anonymous source said, constitutes a "vast industrial capacity and is ultimately very, very dangerous."

What's going on, what's going on underneath, I think, is a collective toying with the fate of the Jews. Here is Iran shamelessly, publicly, speaking of its genocidal fantasy, the liquidation of the Israeli people, i.e. the Jews who brought the Land back to life and even rule over Haram a-Sharif.

Well, that is no good. My guess is that the repulsive and cowardly P5+1 people are also motivated by their own feelings about Jews, about Israel, because I think that is the real nuclear core of this nuclear issue. Here are these goyim in constant conversation over the power of Iran whose goal is our destruction.

Prime Minister Netanyahu spoke to his cabinet on Sunday, and in addition to mentioning the specifics of the rumored deal, JPost reported, he criticized "the international community for continuing its talks with Iran without being troubled by that country's support of global terrorism."

Just what I said.

He also said, "The fact Iran continues its murderous terror activities around the region and the world, does not, unfortunately, bother the international community."

I agree, only I would make the observation and that in Jewish communities in history, leaders did not complain about "the international community" but the goyim, the nations of the world. How they gang up on us in every generation and run their brains around exterminating us, G-d forbid.

The media today showed us a nice photograph from Geneva of two Iranians on one side standing nicely next to Secretary of State of John Kerry and the U.S. Energy Secretary, one Ernest Moniz.

I think that as Obama, friend of Bill Ayres and Bernadine Dohrn, became president in revenge for the worst of the 1960s, so John Kerry, the Viet Cong's errand boy, has come to power. How has it happened that Kerry and Obama, two of the most repellent people in politics, got to be president and secretary of state who today toy with empowering Iran in its quest to destroy us, G-d forbid, and then after that the U.S?

After all, Bill Ayres is on record calling the U.S. an absolutely horrible country, a menace to the world, so Obama entered office and launched his Apology Tour. How has the country been thus burdened with these terrible men?

DPP blogger Zach once sent me the link to the Swift Boat video of, I guess, a dozen years ago, men who knew Kerry in Viet Nam and seemed to be of the unified opinion he was one major horse's hindquarters of a man.

And Obama? I think one of the good things in recent days has been the legitimizing of ever increasing attacks on him, starting with Rudy Giuliani, and today's straight talk from Louisiana Governor Bobby Jindal who said that Obama has "disqualified himself as commander-in-chief." And I say, "Bull's eye."

I have not known much about Jindal and did a little research today. He seems to be one impressive man and sort of the apotheosis of the American dream. His parents emigrated from the Punjab. He was born in Baton Rouge. He was his high school valedictorian, evidently a good tennis player. He went on to college at Brown in a special program guaranteeing a place in medical school even as he just began college. He was accepted at the end of the program at Harvard Medical School but chose to be a Rhodes Scholar in Oxford.

To look at him is to see an Indian. To listen to him is to hear a Red, White and Blue American son of immigrants who knows what his parents left behind and how great America has been to all of them.

How heart-warming it was to see him today on TV, speaking yesterday in Washington on the Capitol steps and saying what he said: that this character has disqualified himself as commander-in-chief of the military in America being attacked and threatened by Muslim maniacs whom he refuses to call Muslim maniacs. Obama wasn't in office even a year when the Ft. Hood horror erupted and he said Islam had nothing to do with it. He should have been removed from office then.

Now, it seems the idea is finally entering more and more of the minds of the electorate.

And of course, from our perspective here, from mine, I've thought from day one he is a Louis Farrakhan clone who contrarily hides the very same satanic hatred of Jews. Just check out the photographs in the MSM of Bibi and Obama sitting next to each other before the press, with Obama's chin tilted up and jutting, conveying the menace of a street thug challenging Bibi, sending the message, "I'm going to get you, Jewboy."

His series of insults to Netanyahu was not for anything Bibi ever did to him but who he was and what he presents. Bibi personally has killed Believers as a member of Israel's elite commando unit. He is also prime minister of the infidel Jews, whom the Qur'an calls a Believer's worst enemy, who also actually rules over Believers and controls their lives and abuses them.

The question then becomes how to address Congress in light of the reality that the President of the United States is as sick in his head about Jews as lots of other Muslims.

Yes, what should Bibi say in his address, which like others, yours truly believes, has to be the address of a lifetime? He wants to persuade Congress, leastwise two-thirds of them, to cancel whatever deal Obama comes up with which lifts sanctions and permits the Iranians to keep plunging ahead.

If Bibi succeeds, then surely the antiJews will screech, "The Jews are running the United States, controlling Congress! It is the International Jewish Conspiracy!" That's what Hitler thought and said.

Well, I think Bibi should start his speech, then, by recalling nostalgically and warmly the relations between Jews in America and American Negroes in the 20th century, with a view to eventually reminding his audience (and of course the president) of all the good that Jewish people did for Negroes that led to the great achievement of having, finally, him, an African-American, elected president. How happy this American Jewish community was, he should say -- the same community that in 1909 created the NAACP, still the largest self-help organization for today's African-Americans.

Bibi might remind his audience of how the NAACP's first president was not an African-American but a Jew, Arthur Spingarn, who contributed his own money to getting that organization on its feet and sharing the Jewish people's knowledge of community organizing for real; self-help organizations independent of the government.

In 1954, the Supreme Court ruled that American apartheid in schools -- segregation -- was inherently illegal. The lead attorney for the Negroes, for the NAACP, in Topeka, Kansas against the school board, was Thurgood Marshall, eventually the first Negro Supreme Court Justice who was assisted by attorney Jack Greenberg, another New York Jew, whose career in the law was crusading for the rights of Negroes.

A decade later in 1964, three civil rights workers were murdered in the deep south, one a local Negro and two friends/colleagues, both New York Jews, because that was the Freedom Summer which saw busloads of idealistic, white, northern, college students going south to help fight the injustice of racism, with, by one estimate, a quarter of those idealists, Jewish college students, which makes sense. That is about 100 times larger than the size of the Jewish community percentage-wise.

The next year saw the march on Selma, though, oddly/pathetically, the current, much praised Hollywood movie with that name about that time, one might say nastily, so to speak, photo-shopped out of that story the presence in the front lines of Rabbi Abraham Joshua Heschel who also put his life on the line for the cause.

Bibi might also go back to the 1930s, the Big Band Era when Benny Goodman's so successful band traveled from town to town and refused to lodge in hotels that that did not accept his Negro musicians.

Bibi might call to mind the wonderful music of *Porgy & Bess*, a true, homegrown American opera about black life composed by George Gershwin.

He might mention the first black actor to have a starring role on a successful television series, Bill Cosby, thanks to producer Sheldon Leonard.

And Bibi might end it all by expressing the happiness of the Jewish community, to repeat, that Obama was elected, a milestone in American history. And then Bibi might add that he simply cannot believe that Barack Obama is such an ingrate, such a betrayer of the Jewish people, which is what all these low-life black race hustlers are.

The wise ones in the Negro community a generation used to say there were white folks and there were Jews, meaning, the latter treated them in a different way.

I remember in the fall of 1960, in a high school on Long Island with two all-white elementary schools in the district and one all black elementary school in the poor Negro section, but mixed junior and senior high schools, the high school football team had an undefeated season and wanted a party, only where to hold it, in whose house, became a problem. Although there were, I think, three Negroes on the team whose contribution was great, there were fellow players who refused to volunteer their homes for the party because it would mean letting "them" into their homes.

The problem was solved after one of the two Jews on the team volunteered to have everybody over. That was my brother, so the victory celebration was held at our house.

This is how used to be, but no thanks to a Jesse Jackson for whom New York was "Hymie town," and Al Sharpton who seems to have been indirectly responsible for the murder of a Jew in Harlem. And no thanks to Louis Farrakhan and Jeremiah Wright and his devoted parishioner Barack Hussein who is, I believe, as much of a Jew-hater as any of them.

Bibi might want to oh so politely insinuate that Obama in his eyes is a betrayer of the Jewish people for taking the side of the Ancient Ones and stalling for six years on Iran's maniacal priests so that they can have a bomb to at least threaten us Jews constantly with annihilation; with terrorizing us, to knock us off our perch as the one nuclear power in the region, take us down a peg, make us frightened, oppress and humiliate us with a new Middle Eastern world order.

On the domestic side of today's top story -- the dreadful news of the anti-Jew deal being cooked up in Geneva -- Isaac Herzog, as YNET calls him, today announced that he has cancelled his speech at the AIPAC Conference next month, which had others commenting was a despicable thing to do. I agree.

In the States, the tradition was "Politics stops at the water's edge" and that should apply here but it does not. That kind of class is foreign to the Israeli Left. Boojie clearly does not want to be shown to be an inferior speaker to Netanyahu, that's No.1. And No. 2, also for political reasons and his own ambition, he refuses to support the prime minister in what is clearly a unitary national concern. He could be a real statesman if he could put that aside, but he is a little man. Fear of Iran a week from Purim is the concern of all Israelis regardless of political inclinations and his refusal to support the prime minister only emboldens our enemies, not only the Muslims but Obama and the P5+1 group of post-Christian Europeans now being menaced big time by the Muslims within.

Even the establishment, middle of the road columnist here Dan Margalit took Boojie to task for this. Boojie evidently had an op-ed piece in the Washington Post on the weekend in which he said Iran does not constitute an existential threat to Israel.

This is disgraceful and it became even more disgraceful by the end of the day when the story broke that the same anti-regime underground in Iran that revealed the existence of the Natanz uranium enrichment facility and the Arak heavy water plutonium plant as well some years back, revealed the existence of another major, secret installation in Iran that the UN inspectors and the P5+1 negotiators never knew existed; a place called Lavizan-3. One wonders how this will influence Bibi's speech and presumptive advice to his audience that Iranians are not to be trusted.

Bibi might throw in how the PLO's liars and butchers were not to be trusted but they were by the Oslo delusionists and why Iran's priest-dictators deserve no more trust than the PLO.

Which brings me back to my opening lament that there are talks at all with these enemies of civilization who bombed to smithereens the Israeli Embassy in Buenos Aires, in 1992, 29 diplomats and visitors dead. Two years later, they demolished the Jewish community center there that contained the archives of centuries of Jewish life in that country, 85 more dead bodies were taken out of that rubble. For decades, Buenos Aires had the second largest population of Jews in the world after New York City. For me the original sin of these talks is not the endless Western retreats but that they were entered upon at all.

Like I reacted today to the news of the successful lawsuit in New York against the PLO by surviving family members of victims of the PLO/PA really.

I find this no less irritating, this successful lawsuit. Not the victory but the oddity of a legal suit at all being filed in New York. Why? The Government of Israel does not know the PA/PLO is responsible for these murders, whose responsible parties are just down the road from the Israeli government? I find it bizarre that these murderous assaults by Arabs

and Muslims against us are not dealt with by the Government of Israel here, with military means.

Yesterday, the electric company shut off the electricity for two hours in Jenin and Shechem after not being paid by the PA for, like, donkey's years. The debt comes to like two billion shekels, like a half a billion dollars. What Israel might do is hand over the customs duties it has been collecting but has held onto because of the ICC gambit and turn the money over to the victors in that New York City court room. I think the money now held in escrow is about the size of the \$200 million dollar judgment.

The lawsuit saw a jury vote its conclusion that the PLO committed all these terrorist horrors and that should trigger, in a healthier Israel, the arrest, trial, conviction and execution of lots of these PA big shots.

But of course that is not going to happen.

So there is so far nothing personal in this charge; they had no relationship. Moreover, the man was reported to be no right-wing defender of Bibi but a member of the old line the old Labor Party.

We shall see how this nasty story pans out.
