Shalom laYehudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim. It's the evening of the 6th day, *dales beSivan, tav-shin-ayin-beh, Parashas BaMidbar*, the evening of the 5th day, Thursday, 21 May 2015, webcasting from Island Israel, home of the most provincial Jews in 2000 years.

Let's see: last webcast, Tuesday night, I said, "Israelis must learn to understand that the creation of the State of Israel did not put an end to antisemitism, for antisemitism is independent of material causes. It is wholly psychological...Israelis have to learn that the animosity is not reality-based and therefore cannot be combatted by concrete actions. The hatred has no roots in the concrete and Israel's defense must take that into account."

And then we had this eventuality yesterday: The start of three-month trial program of separate buses for Arabs in Judea and Samaria given permission to cross the 1949 cease-line for work.

There were numerous reasons. The practice has been for them to ride the normal Israeli buses with the so-called settlers also commuting to and from work.

In practice, this has meant at close of day workers crowding out Jews, and especially the women. It is an old-old story among the honest if not the politically correct that Western women in the proximity of Arabs in the public square get groped more than they do in a Western city; and because Jews -- unlike Yossi Beilin who is apparently suffering from early onset Alzheimer's -- remember the numerous buses in this country that have suddenly erupted in a fierce explosion, burst into flame, and the lucky have been those who died instantaneously vs. those just horribly and suddenly burnt in agonizing pain screaming until they give up the ghost.

In a word, being on a bus with tens of Arabs from Judea and Samaria can be frightening. It's not your normal commute enjoyed by people in the civilized West.

So after pressure from settler representatives, the Defense Ministry devised a plan to restrict these basically foreign workers to four specific entry and exit points, and provide them with their own buses.

Only, what with Her Highness, Queen of the Enlightened, Federica Mogherini in Jerusalem to meet the prime minister, the prime minister decided this was not the time to initiate such a pilot program and ordered Defense Minister Yaalon to cancel it immediately, which he did by suspending the program even in the very minutes in the Knesset that his deputy Eli Ben-Dahan was singing its praises, which embarrassed him for being ignorant of the directive.

And boy did the Enlightened here have a field day. Zahava Galon of the post-Zionist, post-Jewish Meretz Party quaked, "This is what apartheid looks like!" And her partner in that party, Tamar Zandberg, squawked, "Racial separation is apartheid and there is no way to hide it!"

Yesh Atid's Ofer Shelach called the Defense Minister stupid for making this decision. "Israel gets international criticism and then he cancels the program."

News reports said Bibi disowned the decision to initiate that program and it was domestic and international criticism that drove him to halt it within hours of its commencement.

Btselem also bashed the "discrimination against the Palestinians which is a direct continuation of the conquest and the settlements."

Yes, this is what I had in mind the other day. I think better planning would have not allowed for the coincidence of Mogherini's appearance and the start of the program, but once that error had been made, Bibi and Bogie, I think, made the wrong choice. They took a decision to do something concrete as a remedy instead of pushing back with all their rhetorical might and belief, saying, "This new transportation arrangement has absolutely nothing to do with racism and everything to do with the bloody acts of Arabs here who have shown themselves to be more or less the same barbarians who brought down the World Trade Center, homicidal Muslim maniacs, whose allegedly most moderate leaders also refuse to say that we Jews have the right to be free of their persecution."

I think our leaders have to push back when enemies foreign and domestic shriek "Racism!" as the motive for this new program which enables our security forces to operate more efficiently in defending us from these murdering lunatics.

Racism concerns the physical appearance of people and as such is a dermatological problem. Our problem, by contrast, is religious and nationalistic.

When Americans hated the Japanese after December 7, 1941, it had absolutely nothing to do with the color of their skin, the shape of their eyes, the uniform blackness of their hair. The normal American reaction to Pearl Harbor had nothing to do with

race, and neither does this pilot program. And anyone who uses the words “racism” and “apartheid” is an antisemite, an irrational Jew-hater.”

By backing down like this, Israel lets the enemy feel he has struck a nerve and by this cancellation, Israel sort of admits to the apartheid-like nature of the busing program.

And it is this all too characteristic Israeli reaction to criticism which I attribute to the fact that our average Israeli native, like Bibi and Bogie, grows up in a holy Jewish environment until he reaches army age and finds themselves in the army with a percentage of non-Jews. And not until really after the army when he goes abroad does he get to experience the wider world.

In other words, they are the most provincial of Jews in thousands of years in the matter of not really understanding so-called and misnamed antisemitism, a word I would like to see retired. “Judeophobia” might a better one, and for sure it would be far more accurate and truthful than the mendacious “Islamophobia.”

You know what Islamophobia is? It is denial. It is the attempt to do to non-Muslims what Pres. Obama did after the massacre at Ft. Hood. It is an attempt to make people deny the reality of their senses and their common sense; to persuade them that what they think and what they feel is wrong. Said Obama, “Islam had nothing to do with Ft. Hood,” and by implication anyone who thinks that it did is Islamophobic, has an irrational animus against Islam.

When the head-chopping festivals on TV started some months back, Obama was there to tell you to modify your feelings and thoughts because, you know, during the Crusades, Christians also did terrible things. Moral equivalence is like multiplying two negative numbers and coming up with a positive one. If both sides are guilty of terrorism, Arabs of terrorism and Israeli soldiers of war crimes, the guilt of the Arabs, by comparison, fades. When both sides are guilty, no side is guilty. They cancel each other out.

So yours truly was disheartened by the government’s action yesterday. Again, just for the sake of avoiding pointless clashes with the Enlightened who yesterday shrieked “Apartheid! Racism!” it would have been better to delay until Her Majesty of Enlightened Political Science Dr. Mogherini was no longer in the country. But once that screw-up screwed up, the government should have pushed back at the antisemitic venom spewed at us for “Apartheid in Israel! Racism in Israel! It is the color of these Arabs’ skin that led to this program, you know, because Israelis are racists and just can’t stand the way the Arabians look physically!”

Arutz Sheva also posted an item about a lone soldier on one of these buses later in the day overwhelmingly packed with these Arabs who could easily have overpowered by him, stolen his weapon. Instead, they chose to trip him as he walked down the aisle toward the door to exit and then laughed as he fell on his face.

This is what I was getting at on Tuesday. Israelis have yet to grasp that all this vile criticism cannot be done away with by placating our accusers with some kind of action favorable to the Ancient Ones.

Israelis seem yet unable to grasp that all the concern for the Ancient Ones, all the NGOs that serve them, has nothing to do with a sincere concern for these people and everything to do with an age-old human distemper toward Jews. It used to be called *Judenbass*/Jew-hated and I think it should be called Judeophobia.

Well, speaking before of Dr. Mogherini's visit, it seems to have gone just as predicted. Lying through his teeth, the Prime Minister said he favored the two-state solution, not the one-state solution, only the Balestinians must recognize Israel as a Jewish state. "I am committed to peace," he said.

Well, that's true. We are all committed to peace, us loyal Israelis, Jews, Christians and Muslims are committed to peace in this country. It is what I hate about Peace Now, who portray themselves as the "peace camp," implying that if you don't agree with their idea of surrender, you don't want peace.

More precisely, it is not that their first priority is surrender for surrender's sake. What motivates them is the terrible discomfort they would feel in the presence of gentiles who they fear would consider them racists if they take the side of Israelis against Arabs. I think it was Churchill who said a liberal is someone who cannot, in an argument, defend his own side.

So Bibi continued with his tactic as old as the Bar-Ilan speech of pining for a Balestinian state that recognizes the State of Israel as officially Jewish as Jordan is Muslim, when he knows this is like squaring the circle, saying two contradictory things simultaneously which often is the heart of diplomacy.

Consider today's YNET report on the French draft resolution for the Security Council. France is going to table a text that calls for the end of peace negotiations after 18 months and the world historical birth of the State of Balestine, while at the same time including Bibi's demand that the Ancient Ones recognize Israel as a Jewish state.

In other words, this French Security Council resolution aborning may not be so threatening after all. Methinks its domestic roots in France are as important as any, namely, President Francois Hollande has his eye very much on the Muslims inside his country whose savage breasts he needs to soothe. Yes, he waves the flag of the glorious Palestine liberation struggle but also that of the Star of David on Israel's flag.

Let us remember that too it was Ambrose Bierce, the American writer about a century ago, who in his *Devil's Dictionary* defined diplomacy as "the patriotic art of lying for your country."

This French draft resolution also sounds too much like the Oslo nonsense with its idea of having Fatah police Hamas and prevent them from terror against Israel. What a

delusion that was. According to YNET, “The French plan determines that both sides would have to define the parameters that ensure the security of both Israel and Baalata, which would efficiently and effectively protect the borders, stop terrorism and thwart the smuggling of arms.”

If so, this text is as flakey as the Oslo documents of now almost 22 years ago. Their big idea, which made sense at the time to Beilin, Peres and Rabin, was handing Judea and Samaria over to Fatah who would stop terrorism and protect the borders of Israel meaning not let fellow Arabs cross over to murder Jews.

Once again, what comes to mind is the Einsteinian cliché everybody keeps quoting about his definition of insanity: doing the same thing over and over and expecting new results.

The French text will call for “a just and realistic solution to the issue of refugees.”

There was language like that in Res. 242 of nearly half a century ago now.

And of course the text will call for Jerusalem to be the capital of Israel and Baalata simultaneously.

And never mind such a capital city has never existed in the annals of the human race, let alone such a partnership between two nations sharing a capital, one of whose religions requires it to oppress and humiliate the people of the other religion.

And one can only wonder if the prime minister in his public remarks yesterday, after talking with Mogherini, mentioned how earlier in the day a Muslim in Jerusalem, our capital, deliberately drove his car into three Israeli policemen who were injured but not so badly that one of them and a teammate uninjured were able to shoot the would-be Muslim assassin dead.

One wonders if Bibi pointed out to Mogherini that there are no records of Jews deliberately driving their cars into Arabians and that is because the two communities are so different and why cooperation is a fantasy. Peace will come when the other side and their Jew-hating backers around the world stop trying to kill us and destroy our independence and prosperity.

I want some day to see Bibi tell a foreign politician that because these people are Arabs, they want to steal all the wealth we created -- they are marauders by tradition -- and because they are Muslims, they are incapable of accepting our freedom from their tyrannical culture.

So yesterday the Prime Minister ordered the Defense Minister to suspend a new transportation program for Jews and Arabs in Judea and Samaria, a defense minister who also bent over backwards in his remarks to insist its purpose had nothing to do with anything except security. By implication, racism and apartheid were not involved, while at the same time a protest demonstration by Arabs outside the grounds of Tel-Aviv University was taking place, some of whose participants were Arab MKs, to commemorate the Nakba

that was the result of the birth of Israel. The Nakba was a “catastrophe,” what the word means, so the birth of Israel was a terrible thing, said these Arabs in the demonstration who study at the university and the MKs who make a nice salary in the parliament of the State of Israel. The absurdity and irony and hypocrisy here leave one speechless.

One of the demonstrating Arab students, in the YNET report, said, “Recognizing the Nakba is the only way to solve the existing conflict and achieve peace in the future.”

Translation: Israel must confess its guilt for being born and defending itself against six Arab armies come to kill lots of Jews and steal and steal their wealth.

MK Ayman Odeh said, “You can argue over all kinds of uses, but humanly speaking, you can’t argue with the fact that the Balestinian beople paid the heaviest price.”

To which I say, “Oh yes you can.” A major percentage of the Arabs who ran from the fighting were migrant workers with no property, which is why it was so easy to run. They lost virtually nothing, and certainly not when compared to the far more Jews who fled Arab lands whose roots were often thousands of years old. They lost real property, immovable property, homes, bank accounts, businesses, stores with their inventories, cars.

What is going on here is the battle for barbarism, that is, the struggle of these Arabs to hold onto fantasies that keep them from facing the guilt of the Arabs as the guilty party.

Israel’s war of independence did not begin on May 14, 1948 but six months earlier on November 30, 1947, the day after the UN General Assembly voted for a Jewish state on roughly ten percent of the original Palestine Mandate map, a map creating a jurisdiction called Palestine as a Jewish homeland. That was 25 years earlier, and during that period the British never carried out that mandate. What they did carry out was the creation of an Arab state on 77% of the original Mandate map.

The French had also created two states, Lebanon and Syria, each with a part of classical Palestine.

Still the Partition vote for a Jewish state on only 10% was rejected by the Arabs who the next day started killing Jews big time and continued to do so for the next half-year before May 14, 1948.

That is when the armies of five or six Arab states invaded Israel. Israel did not invade these six Arab states which fact this Arab student at Tel-Aviv U. simply does figure into his moral calculus. For him, the creation of Israel was crime against his people and until Israel confesses its guilt and compensates its victims there will be no peace.

One wonders if Nakba Day demonstrations were a topic of discussion between Netanyahu and Mogherini yesterday and how it is clear that even the best and brightest of these Arabs at university remain barbarians for this sub-civilized need to transfer their own guilt onto their victims.

Coincidentally, PMW (Palestinian Media Watch) reported that Fatah’s official website said no peace until all the ’48 refugees have returned to their homes in Israel.

Again, did Bibi apprise Mogherini of this and if so, what was her reaction?

I am not sure I would want to know.

Part of our problem with European 40-somethings like her is their ever-increasing distance on a daily basis not only from World War II and 1948 but the wars of 1956 and 67 and 73.

With each passing year, we are hearing of her German counterparts who are also re-writing the past in their heads with a narrative according to which the Allies liberated Germany from the Nazis who did not represent the Germans at all. And not only that: the pounding that Germany took from the Allies was one war crime after another so that Germans were the Allies' victims.

Don't be surprised if in the next few years Germans come up with their own Nakba narrative according to which they were the true victims in World War II at the hands of those criminal Allies.
