Shalom laYehudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim. It's the evening of the 2nd day, *kaf-kebes beSivan, tav-shin-ayin-beh, Parashas Korach*, the evening of the 1st day, Sunday, 14 June 2015, webcasting from Jew-baiting central.

Jew-baiting, like bear-baiting, an entertainment among the English for centuries, especially in the 16th century under Henry VIII and daughter Elizabeth I. A bear would be shackled to a post at a leg or by neck collar and in that restricted position be set among by savage dogs.

From my vantage point, I find that fact curious in contrast to the otherwise burgeoning civilization in England in that period: the break from Rome, the English Reformation, the glorious years of Elizabethan England, the age of Shakespeare and Marlowe. On the one hand, the flourishing of English civilization, a people whose language and culture would envelope the world; on the other, savage, sadistic cruel entertainments like this, torturing animals. In Afghanistan some years back, there was an issue of U.S. forces going out on joint, anti-Taliban patrols with Afghanis after which, back at the base, the Afghani soldiers would relax and enjoy themselves by torturing puppies.

The American soldiers, raised in a culture of animal and pet lovers of all kinds, were horrified and protested, and the Afghanis got angry. They had no understanding of the Americans' disgust. It became an issue that went up the chain of command where it was decided that U.S. troops had to respect this pastime in this country.

Well, what you can see today on the Net is a video of Jew-baiting by an Arab, of course misrepresented in the MSM, and especially Israel's MSM as an Ancient

Palestinian provoking Israeli soldiers in Ramallah on Friday, soldiers who lost their cool a bit by his refusal to respect their authority.

And he could respond that way, refusing to respect their authority and repeatedly challenging them when he could easily have walked away, but he didn't, because he knew that in general our soldiers are under orders to avoid provocations and surely because, as the video itself is proof, he knew the confrontation would be videoed.

The incident happened two days ago, and the IDF has already convicted the soldiers and ordered punishment for the use of excessive force.

And yours truly cannot help but be reminded of the incident in Texas last week between a cop and an African-American girl who likewise refused to respect his authority. He also drew his gun, and I think he is out of the force now. The incident here is in the same category, and I would not be surprised if it had been planned.

First of all, I think the IDF's reaction hasty and ill-advised because what I see in this video is restraint by the soldiers. I mean they 1) could have shot and killed this belligerent man in fear he might be concealing a bomb or would whip out a knife. 2) They could have slammed him across the face with the butt of their assault rifles. They did not do that.

I played football, American football, in my boyhood and youth and what I see in this video is a guy being tackled, punched, pinned to the ground, but in the end he gets up and walks away. The violence, as I see it here, was in a class with what goes on on a football field people when a runner gets gang tackled, and a bit more but not by much.

This too, to me, is Jew-baiting. What this Arab did, who towered over the principle soldier, was done in the knowledge that these soldiers would do not much more than they did.

The problem is the relationship between these soldiers in full battle gear and this enemy Arab, pushing and shoving one another, cursing each other out, and only because the soldiers are forbidden to act like soldiers and kill the enemy. The Israeli soldiers are required by the politics of the situation to act like policemen charged with maintaining law and order among fellow citizens whom they must treat with respect.

This is the problem. It is what these barbarians do to us out of Gaza. They fire military mortars and rockets at us; we send in soldiers to take care of the problem but they are supposed to act like a SWAT team in an urban neighborhood charged with, say, raiding a local crack house, with the neighbors observing the operation from the side and applauding the police for ridding them of this unwanted establishment.

Only, when our soldiers enter Gaza to neutralize the gunmen and the rocket boys, the bystanders are not on their side. They are wrongly called "innocent civilians," when I don't think they are innocent at all. They themselves may not be armed and fire rockets at us, but they do attend rallies to cheer on the rocket boys. Last election,

they voted for the Muslim Brotherhood whose charter calls Jews apes and monkeys. These people are not innocent in my mind.

When I was in the States in March, I went to see the smash hit movie by Clint Eastwood "American Sniper" which I found depressing. All the respect to the hero Chris Kyle, but this was a war film unlike all the ones I grew up with on World War II with their tank battles and aerial dogfights and artillery duels, commando raids, mass invasions and beachheads. Here were Chris Kyle and his fellow soldiers acting like an urban SWAT team, targeting individuals with names in their streets and apartments. No battlefields. No battleships shelling and softening up enemy positions on shore before a landing by Marines. All the action was in the dirty streets and allies of Arab towns, the targets not enemy soldiers in uniform but people in street clothes, sometimes even children.

Late today, it was reported that two of the IDF soldiers in that video were given 28-day suspended sentences for being guilty of using excessive force. A third soldier is confined to base for the next 30 days because -- fasten your seat belts -- he cursed at the rioter.

Can you imagine a soldier in WWII being punished but saying something terrible about the Japanese or the Germans?

These Arabs are not fellow citizens. They do not have the rights of a citizen in a confrontation with a policeman who must restrain himself.

What kind of soldiering is this? And I say it is function of the clash we have with these barbarians who mess up your head by mixing up the situations. They shoot mortars into our homes but soldiers must act like city policemen, not soldiers? This is all terribly confusing.

Today in Israel as well, coincidentally, an Israeli panel of military experts, commissioned by the government, 11 high-ranking officers called the NATO Military Committee, generals from Germany, Italy and England, published their investigation into Israeli behavior last summer in Gaza and concluded that not only were there no significant war crimes committed, Israel went over and beyond what was necessary to protect non-combatants on the other side that sometimes cost IDF lives.

Smart move by the government in convening this group to counter the expected report in a few days from the UN Human Rights Council so-called, which by its actions sees Israel as the world's No.1 criminal state when it comes to violations of human rights. You know that the UNHRC has an agenda for each monthly meeting in Geneva of its 47 member-states in which only one issue repeats as a problem in the world from month to month and that is the crucifixion of the Ancient Palestinians by the sadistic, satanic Jews.

I await the day an Israeli representative addresses that body and tells these 47 states that, "You all are acting like a bunch of medieval Jew-haters. You're living in the 16th century when Christopher Marlow wrote *The Jew of Malta* as the Devil Incarnate, and Shakespeare imagined his Shylock wanting human flesh and blood from a debtor,

a pound of flesh -- as if Jews were cannibals or something. What would the Merchant of Venice Shylock want with, do with, a pound of human flesh?

The situation last Friday ended with that big Arab guy walking away. He had some cuts and bruises, but I say he asked for it. This incident was part of hours of Arabs rioting and pelting soldiers with rocks and firebombs. An officer was hit in the face with a thrown rock that may have broken his eye socket and he had to be rushed to hospital.

And why did the rioting go on for hours? Because of Israel's restraint. There are those who see in the video the Arab grabbing for a soldier's weapon as well.

This guy approached them. He got in their faces and refused to back off as ordered. It was act of disrespect for the soldiers as the authority. This Arab clearly does not recognize the right of Jews to be the owners and boss of this Land.

And, unfortunately, Israel itself is responsible for this miserable state of affairs.

On the diplomatic and foreign front for Israel today, we were treated to the thoughts delivered at the Herzlia Conference of Major-General Amos Gilad, former head of Research in Military Intelligence who said, "Our security situation has not been so good in a long time," and what he had in mind was the conventional threat. Setting aside for the moment, Obama helping Iran build an atomic bomb, our surrounding Arab states have not been this quiescent in a long time. Egypt has its hands full with jihadis; Jordan is no military threat and swamped with refugees. Syria, Gilad went on to say today, no longer exists. He said, "I would like to announce the death of Syria. Assad still gets a salary as president but governs only one-third of the country. Southern Syria is under al-Qaida, northern Syria is controlled by ISIS, which is expanding but not getting close to our border with Syria."

And Hezbollah remains deterred, he said, despite their possession of all those rockets. Maybe a quarter of their 30,000 armed men are in Syria fighting to save Assad by fighting Jabhat al-Nusra a.k.a. al-Qaida and ISIS and other Sunni groups who want to bring Assad down – when they are not fighting one another.

In another words, unlike years past, none of our immediate neighbors poses a threat to us.

Remember too that a dozen years ago, Saddam Hussein was still in power and had a huge army at this disposal, like a hundred divisions or something. Well, that is all gone now. As an American, I was opposed to the invasion of Iraq as a way of installing democracy, and I also thought it was the invasion of the wrong country; it should have been Iran. But as an Israeli, I was glad to see Iraq destroyed as a military threat to us. We have forgotten how until 2003, Iraq was a major headache. Well, that major threat is now all gone.

And one major reason is the collapse of these states invented by Western imperialists, fools like T.E. Lawrence/“Lawrence of Arabia” who believed in boosting the Arabs back toward the greatness he believed they once had. In 2003, likewise, the Americans tried to create a free, liberal democracy in Iraq. The army was trained and taught what it means to be the army of a democratic people, but of course all in vain, for the simple reason that the Arabs have never risen to nationhood. There is no real Iraqi personality. They are divided groups that never wanted to come together. That unity was imposed on them by Churchill and Gertrude Bell/the British Empire. They remain tribal, sub-national.

Look at the 1400-year long dispute between Sunnis and Shiites which is basically about the proper way to transfer power from one caliph to the next. The Sunnis recall the election of Muhammad’s right hand man by his closest disciples. The Shia think the caliph should be descended from Muhammad, from his family, and these two camps have been fighting and killing one another over this dispute for 14 centuries.

Put another way, this is a way of life for them. It is a chronic condition and perhaps not until Moshiach arrives will these barbarians change.

Look at what’s happening in Yemen and Libya. Last week, there was a report of a clash there between ISIS boys and, according to Reuters, “another Islamic force that later declared jihad against its hard-line rival... Fighting erupted in Derna in eastern Libya after a leader in the Islamic umbrella groups called Majlis a-Shura was killed, apparently for refusing to swear allegiance to ISIS leader Bakr al-Baghdadi.” Evidently, he died along with some 20 of his followers in that shootout.

And not for the first time I suggest not to worry too much about the names and the allegedly ideological and doctrinal disputes between Islamic State and Majlis al-shura. This is nothing but the Arab version of the Bloods and the Crips going at it, the Sharks and the Jets. The PLO did this too. Each of its cells had some fancy-shmancy political-sounding name but in the end they were just gangs led by thugs, extortionists and bully boys.

And this is what’s going in Syria and Iraq and Yemen. The Arabs have never matured politically above family and clan and tribal organizations. They are very much like the Mafia in Sicily and thus are ruled by gangsters like Gaddafi and Saddam Hussein, etc.

And the same goes here for Fatah and HAMAS. The division between them is portrayed by fools and ignoramuses like Peres and famous scientists of politics like Dr. Martin Indyk and Dr. Joseph Beilin as an ideological and religious split.

And I say, “Balderdash.” For whatever reasons, the Arabs objectively judged are a paralyzed, retarded people who never have progressed from tribalism and superstition, Dark Age fantasies of Jews as Devils, and thus it is a fool’s game and has been since 1993 to try to work out some cooperative agreement with them.

Israel must cease trying to deal with the Arabs as if they were members of Western civilization with its preference for liberal democracy and the noble value of compromise. The entirety of the Oslo delusion was that as Israel was willing to compromise and share

the land west of the river under certain conditions -- this is how Bibi still talks -- so were the Arabs willing to compromise because they are just like us.

Nonsense. Israel must begin to observe the Arabs as they are and govern them as they govern themselves: with an iron hand. Everywhere there is a dictator who is necessary to ride herd on people chronically opposed to civilization. The Arabs never quite came in from the desert which, by the way, was the symbolism of Yasir Arafat's keffiyah, he who never appeared in public without that rag on his head, the headdress of a desert Arab.

Likewise Edward Said the professor of English Literature at Columbia University on the cover of his autobiography where he chose a photo of himself as a boy dressed up, like a boy in the West on Halloween dressed as a cowboy, only in his case like a desert Arab in a keffiyah, wearing a galabia/smock, a sash, and parked in the sash a dagger. For Arabs, the romantized past is not the cowboy on the range but a Bedouin armed robber.

To this day the Arabs, their leaders and statesmen, go overseas to conduct business dressed in their traditional Arab, desert robes.

If our strategic situation, as Amos Gilad said, is good, in large part that is because the artificial Arab states created by the West have collapsed and the locals have reverted to a traditional lifestyle of tribe vs. tribe locked in eternal, violent combat.

As it said during the Biblical prophecy of Ishmael's birth, Genesis 16:12, he will be a "wild ass of a man, his hand against everyone, and everyone's hand against him, and over all his brothers he will dwell." In the Hebrew that is *al penei ekhav*, "in their face," like the modern English expression "in your face."

Like that Arab provocateur last Friday, who got in those soldiers' faces and created an incident.

Also, in keeping with the previous *tour d'horizon* as they say in French, a survey of our strategic condition, let us not forget the blow in Turkey a week ago sustained by the lunatic, antisemitic Sultan Recep Tayyip Erdogan who lost his majority in the parliament. That was a blessing.

Talk about retardation in the political life of Muslims. In his 12 years in power, he built himself a presidential palace costing \$615 million with 1,150 rooms. This is like the Palace of Versailles in the 17th and 18th centuries.

What we have here with the Arabs is the persistence of cultural traits that are ages old. The Ottoman Sultans were like this. In the mid-19th century, in the last decades of their corrupt reign, the Sultan had a harem of some 1500 women and hundreds of castrated black African eunuchs to tend to them. With these Turks, there is no end to their appetite. They are never sated with enough money, enough women.

And this is the guy that Obama chose as his expert on Middle East affairs, this brute of a Jew-hater. Thank heaven he lost his majority, this oriental, Sunni despot who has jailed scores of journalists and army officers who do not like him.

And as for his neighbors, the Shiite priests in Iran, we had more news today of their President Hassan Rouhani -- you know, Mr. Moderation, with the killer smile -- directly contradicting the nonsense out of the mouths of Obama and his flunkey Jack Lew who say the agreement they are working on will include constant inspections by outside monitors of Iran's nuclear project. But Rouhani said the other day, "No way, Jose."

And by the way, the pabulum purveyors at the Jerusalem Post whose editorialists bent over backward have apologized to Jack Lew for being booed last week at the Post Conference in New York. Our lives are at stake and threatened by Iran's bomb project as no other threat in our history, with Jack Lew, another IBJ (Inside the Beltway Jew) playing flunky to the enemy Muslim in the Oval Office.
