*Shalom laYehudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim.* It's the evening of the 2nd day, *dales beMenachem Av, tav-shin-ayin-heb, Parashas Devarim*, the evening of the 1st day, Sunday, 19 July 2015, webcasting from ground zero for world aggression.

Today the news made it seem as if we really had to circle the wagons because the goyim are attacking from all sides.

Let's see: Obama just disrespected the bill requiring him to give Congress two months to study his brilliant deal with Iran but there he is and using errand girl Samantha Power running to the Security Council right away to affirm the deal right now. And what's really weird and indicative of the rampant antiJewitis here is that the Security Council is dominated by the very same countries that made the deal. The P5 + 1 means the five permanent members of the Security Council plus Germany, and here is Obama wanting the Council's support for what was decided by the same countries in Vienna It is just another double whammy on us Jews.

In my book, I explain how the UN General Assembly over the years began to write longer and longer resolutions attacking Israel requiring separate votes on different sections of the resolution so in one days, in an organization of less than 200 member-states, hundreds of votes could be cast against Israel. A typical resolution might call for several votes and each one might be 155 yeas, 2 nays and 30 abstentions, and you do that five times in the same resolution in one day so that the end of the day almost 500 member-state votes are turning thumbs down on the Jews.

Thus in its first 45 years, the UN General Assembly cast over 55,000 country-votes against Israel. It has been 26 years since that figure was reached so it must be

around 100,000 country-votes against Israel now in the seventy years of the United Nations' existence.

Today the International Criminal Court, created in the late 1990s by the UN, has just re-opened its investigation into Israel's criminal aggression against the poor, poor, Turks and others aboard the *Mavi Marmara* in 2010, and never mind the video evidence that the IDF forces were attacked before they even hit the deck.

When Prime Minister Netanyahu agreed to pay compensation to Turkey, I thought that was a huge mistake, like his Bar Ilan "confession" that he too believes that the Balestinians have a right to a state in Judea and Samaria.

So that was one or two attacks from that flank in today's news, along with the violation by that chronic liar Obama running to the Security Council.

And then we learned that Federica Mogherini, fresh from Vienna where she and others decided to give Iran 150 billion dollars even as Iran publicly threatens the US and the West with annihilation, tomorrow she will convene all 28 foreign ministers of the European Union of states to deal with another pressing issue apart from Iran's nuclear project and that is the absence of a state for the Ancient Palestinians.

Tomorrow in EU headquarters in Brussels, these unelected bureaucrats will convene to discuss the stalled, alleged peace talks between Israel and its victims. The EU feels it is urgent that all of Europe pressure the Jews to hand over land to the Ancient Ones.

And never mind that no group of human beings in our position would do what these enemies demand that we do. They want Israel to drive hundreds of thousands of Jews from homes they have every right, moral and legal, to live in. They want Israel to retreat from the high ground taken from the enemy in 1967 and turn it back to the Arabs so they can create a State of Balestine. This is what Mogherini and her enlightened fellow Europeans want to see. And that Israel does not bend to their demands, well, Israel will suffer.

We are surrounded on three sides by 550 million mostly Muslims whose religion religiously hates us Jews, but we are the bad guys.

These Muslims seem to be in one of their periodic blood convulsions. They are always murdering one another. In Gaza just yesterday, six cars belonging to Hamas and its rival Islamic Jihad were blown up by ISIS. It is now a three-party struggle for power there – and never mind Fatah which is sidelined. It is a political contest but not one conducted as in civilized societies via the ballot box. This is Araby where political factions duke it out in the streets with assault weapons, RPGs, hidden bombs, bombs in each other's mosque.

And it is to such people Federica Mogherini and her fellow enlightened Europeans, all 28 foreign ministers, will gather to order us to surrender, to retreat, hand over the high ground to the Arabians, these Hamitic, Ishmaelitic, violent people.

They gotta be kidding, or they are classical antiJews in their insensate ability to empathize with us, imaginatively see themselves in our shoes. They demand of us what no human beings would ever agree to.

And in this fever of antiJew cogitation, not only do these goyim give us a hard time by their obsession with us, they do immense harm to people who could use their help. About six weeks ago, it was reported that fighting between the infant government of the new state of South Sudan and rebels has sent 100,000 people fleeing for their lives to join an initial 2,000,000 people who have run in South Sudan since the fighting began two years ago. Is anybody at the Human Rights Council paying attention?

Yesterday in Iraq, one side, ISIS, had a great victory, leastwise as Arabs define victory. Not a victory on a battlefield but a hidden bomb planted in a market town by ISIS, a largely Shiite town, that exploded and killed 130 people.

That was some explosion, and one can imagine that the bomb builder afterwards was the recipient of affectionate slaps on the back from his colleagues for his holy slaughter. “Way to go, Ahmed. Cool. 130 dead. Whatta guy!”

These are our neighbors and all the ICC can do, and the UNHRC, and the EU is point the finger of guilt at us and threaten the world’s only, tiny Jewish state for being violators of human rights.

We are the violators of human rights not Ahmed the Bomb maker and all the bomb makers of Arab and Islam.

Last Thursday, the Prime Minister accused the International Criminal Court of “hypocrisy” for singling out Israel again over the *Mavi Marmara* incident of five years ago – at the same time that Assad in Syria is dropping barrel bombs and chemical weapons on his own people.

Though I think Bibi’s choice of the word “hypocrisy” is a cousin of his unfortunate Bar Ilan speech. “Hypocrisy” is not quite the right word in this situation. The right word is “antisemitism,” the smearing of Jews with guilt as a diversion or distraction away from the truly guilty elsewhere.

Like Mordechai Kedar, mentioned last time, I think Bibi is another Israeli who never experienced antisemitism in his formative years and does not notice it when he should.

Here was just yesterday Signorina Mogherini -- or is it Dottore Mogherini with a PhD in Political Science? -- erstwhile member of the Young Communist League in Italy or something, in Vienna smiling at the Iranians, giving them billions, smiling at their eventual A-bomb production then flying on her broomstick back to Brussels to address all foreign ministers in Europe as they ponder what to do with us Jews, we stiff-necked crucifiers of the Ancient Palestinians for not handing over the land that Israel stole in 1967.

I think Bibi is like other Israelis whom I have known and especially in his age cohort (basically mine) who not only did not experience antisemitism in their formative years, they were taught by the secular Zionist culture here that antisemitism was also

to a serious degree not only the result of antisemitic haters but Jews themselves and the way they behaved and mistreated the gentiles. Israelis like these are uncomfortable with the thought that the Jews were 100% innocent. They had to have had some role in having people hate them.

Such was one thread in the skein of sabra thought in those early years.

Speaking before of our antagonists firing from all sides, in another situation, on Friday, the U.S. State Department warned Israel to do nothing against a recently thrown-up, jerry-built, so-called Balestinian village in the south Hebron Hills next to historic Sussiya with its historic, restored ancient synagogue, a project overseen by my late friend, Rechavam Ze'evi, *by'd*. Israel wants to tear down this so-called Palestinian village built with no license from any authority, sort of like a settler outpost, only in this situation the State Department wields an entirely opposite policy. The State Department of course has wanted for years to see the destruction of illegal settlements, illegal even by Israeli law. The State Department of course smiled over the destruction of Gush Katif ten years ago. That's okay.

But when it comes to Israel tearing down an illegal Arab settlement threatening to become permanent, Israel is warned that this will be "harmful and provocative."

According to coverage in the Jerusalem Post, the EU bureaucracy also has its own representative on the scene there, representing the EU to the PA, one John Gatt-Rutter, and he is not alone. There are 23 other Euro-representatives to the PA here, as if the PA were a state and all these were ambassadors, all of whom of course line up behind the EU's point man Gatt-Rutter to defend the Ancient Ones from having their settlement of like 300 people now at Sussiya destroyed like Gush Katif.

According to EU point man Gatt-Rutter, Israel "has a duty to facilitate Palestinian development in these areas occupied by it, including Area C, which represents over 60 per cent of the West Bank."

And I say, "No, Israel does not have such a duty. We are under no obligation to develop our mortal enemies. What kind of ethical system is this? We don't owe the Arabs in Judea and Samaria a damn thing."

This land was recognized as the Jewish people's ancient homeland by the League of Nations which recognition was included in the UN Charter.

It was Jordan that was in unsanctioned, illegal occupation of Judea and Samaria for 19 years and used it to launch murder raids by fedayeen to kill our people sometimes in their beds. In 1967, the Jordanians tried again and failed to take land that we brought back to life and kill as many of us as they had to do that. But we pushed them back and took the land away from them and we are under no obligation to return it and no obligation to make citizens in our state of the Arab non-combatants who did not run away with the Arab Legion in 1967.

This Gatt-Rutter, Maltese, I think, whose native language is half-Arabic, said, as he looked at the Jewish community of Sussiya, “We can see the settlements which surround this piece of land (meaning the Arab cluster). “The EU, which you know has a clear position on settlements which are illegal according to international law and threaten the viability of a two-state solution, in which the EU has a profound and significant interest.”

I find this an excellent specimen of antiJew thinking in our time. Here is this EU bureaucrat seeing Arabs surrounded by Jews when of course, looking at the big picture of the region, it is Arabs who surround us.

Notice too the use of the “two-state solution” which is a euphemism for another round of driving hundreds of thousands of Jews from their homes as they have been in generation after generation.

And notice the lie that these Jewish communities are illegal when that is demonstrably false. Jewish communities in Judea and Samaria were pronounced legal by the League of Nations Mandate. The Mandate did provide for the severing of eastern Palestine, the east bank, and that happened as it was set aside for Arabs. But otherwise the Mandate was explicitly a mandate to create a Jewish homeland in the Jewish people’s ancient homeland. It is all there in black and white.

But what I find most interesting in this specimen of antiJew cogitation by a European antiJew was his statement that “the EU has a profound and significant interest in the two state solution,” which I find, simultaneously both true and false.

It is false because Europe has no material interest whatsoever in events here. It is all psychological. There are not natural resources or business at stake.

But it is also true that the Europeans dare not refrain from Jew-bashing because then they will be accused of being our accomplices and that could mean a return to the bad old 1970s when Europe was pummeled by Arab terror until 1980 when the forerunner of the EU recognized the PLO as a legitimate organization, when it was no more legitimate than the Mafia. It was and remains a criminal organization of massacre artists, terrorists who plant bombs in airplanes and blow them out of the sky. Europe was mugged into recognizing the PLO.

But on a deeper level, I accept that to Europe the two-state solution is of profound and significant interest, for Europeans have been obsessed with the Jews from time immemorial; the resurrection of the barren Land of Israel by us Jews, we who returned home after 19 centuries of homelessness, of rootlessness, of living on sufferance everywhere, in exile, or so Christians said because we had killed our messiah. Well, have we been forgiven? I mean, what are we Jews doing back in Eretz Yisrael and making it bloom again? Maybe that explanation was off the mark.

Consider too how Europeans these days are themselves bereft of religion and national identity. The conventional wisdom is that after the horrors of two world wars, nobody in Europe wants to fight anybody else in Europe any more Nationalism is a terrible thing, a generation has been taught.

And so the vitality of Jewish national life throws them for a loop. Interesting too how Israel's biggest supporters are those Americans who are most ardent in their patriotism, their flag-waving. Both communities are proud of their national identities.

Which is another reason why Barack Hussein Obama, who has no national identity, hates both his own country and Israel.

Last week I was pleased to see and salute the excellent Daniel Greenfield on the FrontPage Magazine site when he called Obama and Kerry traitors. No pulling punches here.

It really is what is necessary to be said, following the Vienna abomination, so similar to the Oslo abomination. This is a kind of madness, real Lewis Carroll stuff. This deal is being made with a country with a record of not keeping deals, so what is going on here?

Well, I think, leastwise for Obama, if not Kerry, who is more of a mystery to me, for Obama is a Muslim who strives toward a goal and licenses himself to say whatever he wants from to moment to moment with zero fidelity to the truth. He says what he says to please his audience in the moment, and then pays no attention later on to what he said. He puffed up his chest when it was reported that the Syrians were using chemical weapons and said, "That is a red line!" and then did nothing about it.
