*Shalom laYehudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim.* It's the evening of the 4<sup>th</sup> day, *vav beMenachem Av, tav-shin-ayin-heb, Parashas Devarim*, the evening of the 3<sup>rd</sup> day, Tuesday, 21 July 2015, webcasting from Israel, target of man's rebellion against G-d.

*Alma dishikra* in Aramaic: a world of lies. And boy is that true. The world is choking on lies.

And I chose the word choking, I think, because I saw today on line a video of conservative political commentator Ben Shapiro being threatened with violence for insisting that Bruce Jenner is still a man.

Sitting next to him on this panel discussion was this other self-diagnosed transgender fellow who could not stop touching Shapiro when speaking to him – his hands were all over him -- and in the end appears to grasp him by the nape of his neck and threatens to send him home in an ambulance. And I said to myself, "This is *One Flew over the Cuckoo's Nest* for real." The world has become an outdoor mental asylum where reality is as the mentally deranged dictate.

Men like this who threatened Ben Shapiro are to me dictators in the same category as Saddam Hussein, Joe Stalin, Adolf Hitler. Ben Shapiro speaks the truth that Bruce Jenner is still Bruce Jenner and he is threatened with violence for his fidelity to the truth.

This is also Islam in practice; they go together, these phenomena. I once saw a TV actor – I forget his first name, {?} Begley -- talking about the environment most passionately who went ballistic as the interviewer seemed to disagree with him. He said

global warming is man-made and must be stopped, the interviewer disagreed, and the actor went ballistic.

There is this totalitarian spirit in the world these days, and another instance of it was on display yesterday in the behavior of the president of the United States and his errand girl at the UN Samantha Power who violated for sure the spirit of the recent Congressional bill and likely the letter of that document which called for Obama to let Congress judge his policy before going to the UN. This guy too, like that guy who threatened Shapiro. is a dictator who has constantly thumbed his nose at the American Constitution and the Congress, the representatives of the American people. He has therefore, by disrespecting them, disrespected the American people as a whole.

This guy is emotionally identified with the enemy, with Iran and is supportive of its Islamic tyranny. In 2009, the regime there stole an election that they lost and killed demonstrators who protested, and it is this government that today Obama wants to give 150 billion dollars and let them keep their A-bomb making machinery.

There is an Alice in Wonderland aroma in the atmosphere, this denying of reality, denying of the truth. In the end, the American nation denies itself.

Once again, after Chattanooga, Obama has refrained from speaking out against homicidal Islam, against Muslim terrorists who license themselves to murder American men in uniform on a base or in a recruiting office, and then watch as the American president denies that Islam had anything to do with these crimes and with the implication that those who blame Islam are Islamophobic bigots.

This man must be removed from office. He is unfit for duty. He is a serial offender of the American Constitution and an antagonist of its fundamental traditions and culture. That is why he said he wanted to fundamentally change America. He did not want to improve America but fundamentally change it because he fundamentally does not like America.

But where is the one American politician with the guts to go public with a call for his impeachment?

We live in a world of lies, a spider web of lies. JPost's Yonah Jeremy Bob reported yesterday that the ICC decision to re-open the case against Israel over the *Mavi Marmara* aggression was based on the judgment that the judge's judgment was wrong, this African woman, Fatou Besouda. The ICC told her that she should have considered more seriously the possibility that the deaths of those killed by the IDF on the *Mavi Marmara* were "systematic or resulted from a deliberate plan or policy to attack, kill or injure civilians."

What's being said here is that the Court wanted the judge to take into consideration the possibility that the killing by the IDF was systematic and resulted from a deliberate plan to attack, kill or injure civilians.

This is like Obama saying the massacre at Ft. Hood had nothing to do with Islam. It is a denial of reality in the highest degree. It is known that those soldiers who slid down those ropes onto that deck were carrying as their principle "weapon" paint

ball guns, which are hifalutin toys, with a handgun in a pocket as a backup they had to resort to. Had there been a deliberate, systematic policy of killing or injuring civilians, don't you think the IDF would have descended with assault rifles slung on their backs?

In addition, we have all seen the videos of the people on that ship with blow-torches cutting metal railings to beat the IDF with when they landed; and they did that in another video, yet here is the ICC with the thought that the IDF purposely sent those soldiers to kill people.

This is a denial as powerful as Ft. Hood. And this is the world we live in. Andrew McCarthy wrote yesterday on the National Review site, "At the UN today, the Obama administration is colluding with our enemies and other foreign sovereigns to deprive the American people – through their elected representatives – the power to determine what obligations they will accept under international law. The Obama administration has taken the position that Russia, China and yes Iran have a vote in our national security, but we do not. And in this betrayal, Congress has, at best, been a witness, an aider and abettor."

I agree. McCarthy uniquely, as a commentator – he was the prosecutor of the Blind Sheik for the first bombing of the World Trade Center in 1993 -- has pointed out the flaws in that recent bill calling on the president to give Congress 60 days to mull over his brilliant foreign policy initiative.

McCarthy wrote pointblank, "The Obama administration is colluding with our enemies." He is right, and I ask, "Where is the effort to remove this man from office? The Constitution allows for it. By not calling for his removal from office, Congress, like him, also violates the Constitution.

The Emperor has no clothes. This man is unfit for the job, steps must be taken, and for sure the very first step is calling for his impeachment.

But no one speaks up and of course everyone has a good reason not to. Again and again, as with the Chattanooga massacre, Obama is on record refusing to call a spade a spade and attach the label Islam to this latest massacre. And it is a massacre. The Boston Massacre of 1770, so famous in American history, was the cavalier shooting dead by British troops of political protestors on Boston Common, five of them, protesting London's abuse of the colonists.

Well, Chattanooga was also a massacre of five Americans, in this case by devotees of a foreign power hungry to gobble up America and really the whole world.

This guy Obama is incapable of identifying the enemy that kills American soldiers in army bases and recruiting stations. And since he cannot even speak the enemy's name, he must be removed from office.

He called this latest massacre a "heart-breaking circumstance, to be killed in this fashion."

"...circumstance, to be killed in this fashion." They were murdered! He makes it sound as if they were riding in a bus late one wintry night navigating down a

mountain road, the brakes failed and the bus went over a cliff. That's a heart-breaking circumstance, an act of G-d.

But what happened in Chattanooga was not an act of G-d but of man. Like the ICC that wants to investigate Israel's motives for killing those nine on that ship, as Muslims deny Islam as the motive behind one atrocity after another done in the name of Islam.

The ICC decision to re-open the case is yet another instance, another episode – they are almost daily now in the global village -- in which the human mind operates as it did in the Middle Ages. Here is the ICC choosing to see our soldiers as ordered to kill civilians and harm them. This is the same as at Passover saying Jews murder gentiles for their blood.

The ICC, the UN-created International Criminal Court, in the year 2015, is being run in a kind of Star Trek time-warp by medieval antisemites.

Speaking, as I always do, of the fires of antisemitism fueling the anti-Israel attacks of the day, which are endless, there was more today on the tussle mentioned last webcast brewing at Sussiya. On the Arutz 7 site, their Ari Soffer filled us in. It seems that land underneath this so-called Balestinian village was after the Six-Day War barren land surrounding the ruins of the Jewish community that had lived there from the 3<sup>rd</sup> to the 9<sup>th</sup> centuries in caves, whose ancient synagogue was later developed as a tourist site.

The modern Jewish community at Sussiya next door was established in the early 1980s and at that time today's so-called Ancient Palestinians were simply not there.

This is another episode characteristic of the entirety of the Zionist return to the Land. As the Jews came in to resurrect the old sod, so Arabs came in to look for work being created by the energetic and industrious Zionists. So at Sussiya today – now the allegedly Ancient Balestinian Sussiya – that is what they call it, oblivious to the historical truth the Arabs never called the area Palestinian anything -- so the name Palestinian Sussiya is more invented history.

And what attracts our attention today is the Israeli court order to demolish the Arab shanties for these some 300 squatters, and the resistance being made to that court order by basically the entire planet. The UN, the US, the EU all have made their positions quite clear that while Jews can be, as at Gush Katif, driven from their homes and their homes bulldozed for being basically illegal, and they illegal squatters, as for the Arabs in Balestinian Sussiya, no, the message from the entire world to Israel is very different. "Don't you dare dispossess even one Ancient Palestinian. This is their ancient village. You Israelis are the occupiers, not the owners." Says the world, says the State Department, "You Israelis do not own this land. This land belongs to the Ancient Ones."

According to Ari Soffer's report, the battle is being waged by NGOs backed by the UK, backed the New Israel Fund. They are representing the Arabs in court and the media efforts. Like B'Tselem, which is also funded by antisemitic goyim overseas.

The upside of this story, though, is always, for yours truly, more evidence it provides that Israel is indeed the Chosen People, chosen by the goyim for these monumental efforts to support the Arabs in Judea and Samaria against us. Look at how they fight for every acre and protest Israeli authority everywhere, resisting Israel's decisions to act like the legitimate landowner.

Thus the mantra, and it is a mantra of world anti-Jewry these days, according which the "settlements are illegal under international law"; and it is common knowledge that all of Judea and Samaria is rightfully land belonging to its ancient landlords and stewards, the Balestinians. Everybody knows that. That is why every permanent building built by Israel since 1967 is deemed illegal.

And you can call me an oddball but behavior on the part of the UN and really the whole world makes yours truly smile. Precisely because there is an international consensus that this is the Holy Land; and precisely because the world is united over that fact, Israel cannot be allowed to own it. Israel no right to rule over this tiny piece of real estate.

Yesterday in Brussels, the EU foreign ministers, over two dozen of them, under the direction of the erstwhile Young Communist Federica Mogherini, resolved that "The EU reiterates its strong opposition to Israel's settlement policy and actions taken in this context, such as building the separation barrier beyond the 1967 line, demolitions and confiscations -- including EU funded projects -- evictions, forced transfers, including of Bedouins, illegal outposts, settler violence and restriction of movement and access."

Quite a bill of indictment. The statement also concluded that "these actions seriously threaten the two-state solution."

And then at the end, a guilty admission, so to speak, there was one sentence only in which the foreign ministers said, "Recent rocket fire from Gaza by militant groups is unacceptable and underlines the danger of escalation."

You got that? Pinning the tail on the donkey, Israel is stuck many times with a laundry list of crimes, but as for its antagonists, no, we are not even sure who they are. The foreign ministers' resolution said rocket fire out of Gaza was unacceptable but did not name those firing those rockets. Just some "militant groups." Not Hamas, not Islamic Jihad, not the Balestinians, that's for sure.

This is the face of antisemitism in the year 2015. This is the collective wisdom of all the foreign ministers in Europe, that continent with its 450 million people, and their judgment that includes specifically calling out Israel by name for being guilty of a half-dozen crimes while its adversaries are not even named. Just some vague reference to some "militant groups."

Before the rise of the phantom Palestinian nation, as my book shows, the New York Times did not hesitate to refer to Arab terrorists killing Jews in Israel -- that was the language in the 1950s and 60s, without using any quotation marks around the expression

Arab terrorists. They started doing that in the 1970s to signal to the Arabs that this is what the Israelis call the PLO killers but not the New York Times. Of course, because the Times began to see them as “freedom fighters.”

In fairness to the Times, they had to protect their journalists on the scene because the PLO made it clear that if you call us terrorists, we will kill you.

In fairness to the chorus of European foreign ministers under the direction of Kapellmeister Mogherini, Israel bears much blame for this state of affairs in which the EU and individual European states take the side of the Arabs in their lying perversions of history such as the thousands of years Balestinian Sussiya’s existence.

Yours truly longs for the day Israel stops acting this way and proudly announces to the world that Judea and Samaria are legally and morally the property of the State of Israel and that Israel will treat the Arabs in these areas with utmost respect as individuals but will not let them vote in our Knesset.

The Europeans are forever shrieking that we are in illegal occupation of Palestinian territory and Israel never confronts this accusation head-on and defeats it by making the opposite claim. “No, this land is legally, according to the League of Nation and the United Nations Charter, our land.”

Israel might also avail itself of my book that makes plain that at this very movement, 53% of classical Palestine is in Arab hands. And if the governments in Amman, Damascus and Beirut want to hand over this 53% to what they claim is the Ancient Palestinian people, Israel will not try to stop them. They can create a Palestinian state on more than half of classical Palestine’s territory, and Israel will remain in possession of the smaller 47% that is west of the Jordan River.

Of course this is not going to happen because in truth, in this miasma of lies that poisons the atmosphere, the Arabs have never really another Arab state to come into existence. It has no meaning to them. In 1948, Egypt, Jordan, Syria all invaded and all had dreams of overrunning as much Jewish territory as possible and keeping what they captured for themselves.

Indeed, in the 1920, 30s, 40s the Arabs’ leader Haj Amin al-Husseini said there was no Palestine. It is all Syrian land and Damascus is the region’s capital, not Jerusalem.

Can you imagine? That was the Arab line for forty years, a Biblical generation into the 1960s.

So I don’t expect the Arabs ever to create a Balestinian state and also if only because, like the Kurds, they are incapable of unifying and overcoming their tribal frictions. The struggle for power between Hamas and Fatah is just another variation on the struggle between Sunni and Shiite Muslims, over who gets to rule? The Sunnis say the caliph, the head of the Umma, the Muslim community, is chosen by a council of elders like the first caliph Abu Baker who was the unanimous choice after the death of Muhammad.

Versus the Shiites whose very name *shi'a* means "faction," who broke away and insisted that the caliph like Abu Baker, who was Muhammad's son-in-law, must be a member of Muhammad's family. And these two camps have been at odds over this issue - - who gets to rule and how the ruler is chosen -- for all the 14 centuries of Islam and in certain periods like today frequently kill one another over it.

Imagine living in a Western country like the States or England in which the Democrats and the Republicans contest for power using assault rifles, RPGs, hidden bombs. Likewise in England, the Tories and Labor also go at in the streets. That is what it is like to live in an Arab country.

This is why there will be no Balestinian state: because those Arabs who call themselves Balestinians have proven themselves incapable of peaceful and beneficial self-government.

Everyone remembers that in 2006 Hamas was throwing Fatah guys off rooftops, but few remember the cause. Because after losing the elections in a fair and square contest, the Fatah bureaucrats literally refused to vacate their offices.

On Friday in Algeria, an army patrol was ambushed west of the capital in which nine soldiers were killed, with Al-Qaida in the Maghreb claiming credit.

There also is a local ISIS franchise there calling themselves Soldiers of the Caliphate, though authorities have seriously reduced their power and size by killing many of them after they kidnapped a French tourist and cut his head off.

In light of this fact, the endless gang wars, which is what they really are, in many Arab countries; the constant rebellions by opponents of the ruling clique regime, Israel would have to be as much in denial as Obama to hand over Judea and Samaria in the expectation that the new Arab government would administer a nice and peaceful, friendly new neighbor country call the State of Balestine.

Israelis would have to be as crazy as Shimon Peres and Yossi Beilin to try once again to hand over the high ground to the Arabs here.

But that is what the world expects us to do. It is just the latest case of goyim dehumanizing Jews and expecting us to act in ways no human being would ever act.
