# *DeProgram Program*

*From the Mind of Sha'i ben-Tekoa*

*Transcript*

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*Shalom laYehudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim.* It's the evening of the 2nd day, *kaf-gimmel beElul, Parashas Nitzavim*, the evening of the 1st day, Sunday, 6 September 2015, webcasting from the Land of Israel as Islam conquers Europe.

It's certainly not the first time. The first time was in the year 711 when the Muslims leapt across the Strait of Gibraltar into Europe. The invasion was led by a man named Tariq, and since *jabal* in Arabic means hill or mountain, *jabal Tariq*, means Tarik's Mountain, so the Rock of Gibraltar bears his name to this day. The new name wiped out the old one, the Pillars of Hercules.

In 1683, almost a thousand years later, the Ottoman Turks on the other side of the Mediterranean reached the gates of Vienna but were defeated. And to celebrate, the Christians, who fancied French pastry, created a new one called in French the crescent, alluding to the crescent moon that that symbolizes Islam, so when you bite into and devour your *croissant*, you commemorate that victory that saved central Europe from further Islamic conquest.

And in between, during those one thousand years, Islam was a constant menace to Europeans. There was never peace. In every century, there were raids from North Africa into southern Europe. Constant hijacking of Christian commercial shipping and fishermen and the enslavement of all the crewmen and passengers aboard these ships. They would come ashore into southern France and southern Spain and Italy to kidnap people and turn them into slaves. For a thousand years in every year, there were thousands of Europeans enslaved on the Barbary Coast.

The menace of Muslim hijackers was virtually a fact of life like bad weather or underwater reefs that posed a hazard to civilian ships. And in fact in those years, when most of Europe was still a checkerboard of provinces and dukedoms -- the coming together of the countries that we know as France and Germany and Italy was a process that took centuries -- in those centuries the problem of Muslim aggression on the high seas was a matter for the insurance companies, not national governments. Being kidnapped on the Mediterranean Sea was a risk like storms at seas, like icebergs, a hazard of travel.

For a thousand years, the menace of violent Muslims was a fact of life. And you bet your bottom drachma there was not one European Christian in those centuries who did not consider Muslims to be barbaric. Hence, the Barbary Coast, as the nickname for the southern side of the Mediterranean, the Northern African littoral.

Today, though, what a difference. Here today was the leader of the Germans Angela Merkel throwing her maternal arms wide open to hundreds of thousands of Muslims who are demanding to be allowed to live in Germany among her Germans. And how ironic; it was Merkel a couple of years ago who was the brave one in Germany to declare that integration had failed. The Muslims who came to Germany to live wanted more money and comfort in life but had no desire to become Germans. And every week, it seems, in Germany these days and elsewhere on the Continent, churches are closing their doors and either being converted into mosques or shopping malls.

And I confess: I have never been a feminist so I am not particularly happy with a woman leading the country; it goes against history, and that is because I think women suffer, from time to time, from an excess of compassion. I think if the US Supreme Court this summer had not had three women judges, the sodomite marriage ruling might not have come down. I think the women on the bench are too forgiving of the behavior in question. They see being gay, you know, Barry loves Gary and Gary loves Barry, and if they are happy, who is to say no?

It is not that I am opposed in all circumstances to a woman leading the nation. Look in the Bible, at Dvorah, one of the Judges. Look at Margaret Thatcher. I'd be happy to have her head my government any day.

But in general, too much compassion can be a vice and a weakness, and here Angela Merkel, acting in complete opposition to her own honest reading of the situation in her country some years ago, what is she doing? Is she crazy bringing all these Muslims into Germany?

The only one speaking truth in Europe is PM Victor Orban of Hungary who last week told all those refugees not to come to Europe but to remain in Turkey. When asked if it was not immoral to close Europe's doors as he was demanding, he said no, just the opposite. It was immoral to encourage these people to come into Europe. He expressed fear for the collapse of Christian society.

Of course the other leaders in Europe almost had a case of the vapors, I am sure, when he said that word. The moral thing to do, he said, the humane thing to do,

is to be clear and say to these refugees, "Please don't come. Turkey is a safe country. Stay there. It is dangerous to come here." He said tens of millions of Muslims coming into Europe would destroy it.

Orban even dared to say that Hungary would give asylum and refuge to Christian refugees only. Israel Hayom reported today other East European countries are in agreement with him on this but in the West, of course, the movers and shakers were very angry. The foreign minister of Luxembourg Jean Asselborn said, "Orban should be ashamed of himself."

Coincidentally, this same Jean Asselborn was in Israel today and met Uncle Shimon whose politics he shares. This Asselborn has been a radical left jackass since his student days in the 1960s and of course has a solid record as an anti-Jew, a crusader for our mortal enemies the Muslims and the Arabs masquerading these days as Balestinian victims of racist, fascist, colonialist, imperialist Zionists like me.

In Israel, the reaction to this invasion of Muslims into Europe expressed itself in the demand of the opposition leader Isaac Herzog that Israel also open its doors to these Syrian refugees, as the prime minister backed by other Likud ministers declared that Israel would not absorb them. He said Israel "must control its borders against illegal immigrants and terrorism. Israel is a very small country that lacks demographic and geographic depth."

Opposition leader Boojie Herzog of course responded to that by accusing the prime minister thusly: "You've forgotten what it means to be a Jew."

The head of the Meretz Party Zahava Galon also demanded that Israel absorb thousands of these Syrian Arabs, and of course, as always on the left, logic and facts play no role in their thinking. One who does not agree with their views is an immoral person, unfeeling and greedy; that was the gist of it.

Of course the irony here is that if anyone has forgotten what it means to be a Jew, it is Boojie, who seems oblivious to the historical truth of this state that he wants to lead was created as a land of refuge for the Jewish people because in every generation they were hounded from country to country and often no country would accept them. Fleeing Spain in 1492, Jews, for example, crossed over from the Costa del Sol, the south coast of Spain, to North Africa, boatloads of them running for their lives who landed on beaches but never got off them because the locals, the Muslims, would not let them. They stood guard until the Jews on the beach died of starvation and exposure.

In 1938, the Evian Conference attended by scores of states and NGOs to discuss what to do with the tidal wave of Jews wanting to flee Germany and Poland and other countries, and not one of them opened its doors.

Boojie seems not to know that the majority of people who came to Israel over the last 150 years of the Zionist enterprise were not Zionists. They were not idealistic dreamers. They came because they had no choice. If other states had given them refuge, they would not have come to Israel.

Recently, relatively speaking, think of the one million-plus Jews and non-Jews and their families who left Russia in the 1990s and came to Israel because the Israeli government pressured the US to limit the number it would admit. This forced all those people to come here.

But what Boojie the Dufus seems to forget, something he surely is aware of, is the precarious lives in Europe right now of hundreds of thousands of Jews living in France, England, Holland, Germany and Sweden who any day now might also find themselves in the classic Jewish position of having to run for their lives and they will need a place to run to; so Israel must reserve this country for Jewish refugees and not Syrian Arab ones.

What Boojie and the Enlightened here today forget is that Israel must look out for its own and not be embarrassed to do that.

*Im ain ani li, mi li?* If I am not for myself who will be for me?

So what to do with this tidal wave of people fleeing from Syria, Iraq and Afghanistan? Quite simply, it is the moral thing to defend one's own society against those who want to change it and replace it and make life more difficult for you in your own country; again those who will want eventually to build a mosque next door to your house with loudspeakers broadcasting at 4:30 in the morning the call to prayer. It is insane of Europe to accept these people.

At the same time, one must do the right thing in the face of suffering. One must be humane in dealing with these people. And one way to do that is to offer to help them financially, to support them, which the EU could do by funneling money from all of its 28 countries to all the 56 Muslim and 21 Arab states whose responsibility it is to care of their Muslim brothers and sisters, *n'est-ce pas?* Let them take them in and let the countries in the West help support them.

I think the US, the EU, Canada, Israel should offer to fund relief efforts at resettlement in countries other than the Christian and post-Christian and Jewish ones in the West. There are dozens, scores of Muslim states where these refugees would not clash religiously with the locals in the least.

For years now in Paris, and I am sure other cities in France as well, at prayer times in the middle of the day Muslim men will walk out into the middle of the street and block traffic so they can pray in public, and to hell with every non-Muslim in the vicinity. Unless the French take back their streets, they will continue to lose their country and this goes for the Germans as well.

Reports coming out of there have become similar to those out of France. It was a Gateway piece a week or so ago reporting on, for example, on how petty street criminals in certain German neighborhoods used to be accosted by police for something. But now, one police car shows up with two policemen, and before you know it, hundreds of the

locals are out there forming a crowd, even a menacing mob resisting the arrest. The police may call for backup but that means scores of cars will be needed, so they are not arresting criminals as they used in these areas. I think Angela Merkel is losing her country.

And Boojie Herzog and others on the Left here today sounded like such jerks. Zahava Galon actually said that by absorbing a significant number of these Syrian refugees, Israel's position in Europe and elsewhere would improve.

This post-Jewish Israeli Jewess has never learned that goy hatred of Jews has never been based on any behavior on our part that we must change in order to make them like us.

The animosity is baseless. It is good that Israel during natural disasters around the world races to the rescue and makes individuals friendlier to us, those who benefit directly from our first-rate doctors and nurses and rescue experts.

But it never changes the larger truth that antiJew hatred is not rooted in truth and there is not much we can do about that. The accusations and allegations are always delusional. All of them are like the blood libel: lies. We Jews who unlike the goyim refuse to ingest even animal blood are accused, basically, of being vampires. We are all a bunch of Draculas.

On Friday, the New York Times ran an op-ed by a German editor under the title "Will Germany succumb to hate?" and you know right away the political coloration of the writer: a leftist. Disagree with the Left and you are a hater. Of course this Anna Sauerbrey was pleading compassion for all these refugees and not once did she use the words "Islam" or "Muslim."

She wrote of "right-wing extremist groups with their hate speech." As usual, it is all emotion, no logic, no sobriety, just name-calling.

On Friday, JPost's Benjamin Weinthal in Berlin also wrote up a Green Party Bundestag deputy, one Uwe Kekertitz -- the Green Party is the radical left there -- who claimed that the security barrier here is worse than the Berlin Wall was. He said this after a brief trip to Israel, and gave a speech in June in Stuttgart to that effect to a church group that sponsored his trip. I think it is available now on YouTube.

It seems two religious NGOs in Germany sponsored the trip. One is run by Germany's Catholic Bishops organization, the other a Protestant NGO. Both of them are of course sick 24-7 over the daily crucifixion of the Ancient Ones. And it turns that even though these church agencies manage these operations, the funding still comes from the German government.

You got that? We have seen this before. The government treats Israel decently, but at the same time funds these NGOs who are this generation's successors to the Christian anti-Semites throughout German history.

This comparison by this deputy in the Bundestag between the Berlin Wall and our security barrier is positively brainless. That, by the way, is a symptom of antiJewitis. When the idea of the Jew enters the brain, the IQ plummets radically. The Berlin Wall, as this man surely knows, was thrown up in 1960 by the Communists in East Berlin to prevent people from escaping to West Berlin and the freedom of the liberal democracies.

Our security barrier by contrast is likewise meant to prevent people from crossing as well, but in this case into Jerusalem not in search of freedom must mass murder.

I imagine that every German member of the Bundestag had a full course of education in his or her lifetime, K-12, university, but if so, how to explain the distortion of thought here in seeing a parallel in the Berlin Wall and our security barrier?

JPost today also ran a story on a museum in Germany, in Aachen, that is sponsoring a speech by a lunatic anti-Jew Jewess – she sounds like a female Norman Finkelstein -- one Lillian Rosengarten, who will accuse Israel of “ethnic cleansing, racism and apartheid.” The local Jewish community organization is of course protesting this program.

I look forward to reading Tuvia Tennenbaum’s book which covers, I think, the sub-surface antisemitism that still exists in Germany. No doubt. This JPost piece cited a defensive board member of this museum defending the program, who said that “criticism of her speech is ridiculous.” He, like another board member, told the Post that when one “criticizes Israel, it is not antisemitism.” And how many times have we heard that?

I say it is most certainly antisemitism and here’s why: Criticism of Israel that is accurate and honest is not antisemitism. Trouble is, maybe 2.5%, 3% is accurate, but a statistician will tell you such a percentage is “statistically insignificant.”

Put another way, when 97%, 97.5% of the criticism is delusional, a pack of lies, then criticism of Israel *is* antisemitism. When a woman like this accuses Israel of crimes it does not commit, you are listening to a delusional antisemite.

No, 100% of the criticism of Israel in our time is not antisemitism, but enough of it is to conclude that in general, criticizing Israel in our time is antisemitism.

Last item: You saw maybe how these five American Jews got lost in Hevron the other day and were attacked by a mob of Ishmaelites throwing rocks and Molotov cocktails. I think they burned their car completely. They survived only thanks to the kindness of an Arab who took them into his house and called the police and the IDF to come rescue them.

This also happened in 1929 in Hevron. Then too a good soul among the Ishmaelites saved Jewish lives.

Before we heard about Muslims in Europe wanting to convert to Christianity, and I wonder: if Israel were to open up toward the Arabs here and offer quickie conversions and citizenship, how many in Judea and Samaria would leap at the prospect? My guess is that they would come in droves.

They don’t do that now thanks in large measure to the danger to their lives were they to act that way. Their neighbors would respond to even the slightest step toward conversion by murdering them.

In any case, the Israeli Rabbinate’s policy on Arab conversion since 1967 has been opposed. But that’s another item for another day.
