Transcript

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Shalom laYebudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim. It's the evening of the 4th day, *kaf-beh beElul*, *Parashas Nitzavim*, the evening of the 3rd day, Tuesday, 8 September 2015, webcasting from Israel blanketed in sand.

We had a heavy-duty heat wave today accompanied by a fog of yellow air. It happens maybe once every couple of years. This one, I think, came down from Syria. The whole region has been blanketed in sand. Hundreds of people in Israel today were treated for respiratory problems. Those who could stay indoors all day did.

This kind of weather, I think, matches one's mood if it is down. And in this current state of the political system of the world, I know mine is. One dismaying news item after another.

Muslims are invading Europe and Europe is waving the white flag. This matches the collapse of Christianity on the Continent; matches the collapse of national unity. The Europeans seem to have no defense against this invasion of Muslims that they have to know they are going to regret.

How many years has it been since we have watched the situation in France deteriorate, blossom really, into hundreds of neighborhoods in France's major cities and towns now basically off-limits to French people, to non-Muslims, which should not surprise? Look at their holiest of cities, Mecca. No non-Muslims allowed on pain of death.

Jerusalem, by contrast, is open to all peoples of all religions. I am a regular at the Western Wall and every time I go, I see tour groups from one country after another.

In Christian scripture, a major episode is Jesus upending the tables of the moneychangers. It has been ages since I read any New Testament but imagine that this is about as violent as he gets in that book.

For sure, the episode reflects the misunderstanding of the first Christians as to the significance of the moneychangers at the Temple Mount. They were there for the same reason that today in the 21st century tourists in the Old City may want to change money, change their foreign currency into shekels. The reason for the moneychangers way back when was the constant visits made by foreigners, Jews and others who when visiting Jerusalem wanted to make a contribution, a sacrifice, to the god of the land, the G-d of Israel. In ancient times, people traveling to different lands would want to placate the local deity, and in the time of Jesus no less people from all over -- including Jews living outside the land -- would come to the Holy City and want to contribute, make a sacrifice at the Temple. Jerusalem is open to the whole world.

In theory, one could, if coming from, say, *Bavel*/Babylon a thousand miles away, schlepp along a Babylonian sheep or goat, but that's a hassle. Far more convenient to change money when you come to the city then buy a local goat.

But I digress. Or maybe not. We began with these columns of Muslims invading Europe as refugees, from Afghanistan and Iraq and Syria, all thanks to the satanic orgies of mass murder carried out by their fellow Muslims, and maybe this is deliberate. I mean, behind so much of the horror is Iran, and in the long run the great exodus could be beneficial to the region. I mean, Syria has been on the brink of being unlivable for its absence of water. So a mass flight of Syrians will at least lessen that problem to a degree.

For example, in 1790 in Tripoli, Libya, there was a drought and the tyrant who made Gaddafi look like a pussycat Bashaw Yusuf came to the conclusion that it was a good time to drive the entire Jewish community into the desert to die of thirst. But Europe is not doing that. And I think their error is tied to their lack of religion and lack of national identity. Their nationality, their society, is under attack and they are throwing up their hands in defeat.

What they are also doing is running to Iran, that is, their businessmen, to make deals, which is like the U.S. and other Western corporations in the 1930s doing deals with Nazi Germany when it was as plain as the mustache on Hitler's upper lip that he was the apotheosis of evil.

And like Hitler's Germany two generations back, in Iran the ideology-driven priests of terror like Hitler's leathered-jacket Gestapo are insane with Jew-hatred.

Memri.org has posted an interview with Iran's Defense Minister Hossein Dhegihan who said his government continues to see the U.S. as the Great Satan, while at the same time today in Washington, Congress was supposed to take up the Iran deal according to which Iran is to be given 150 billion dollars and promised an A-bomb in the future -- and never mind pronouncements like this one out of Iran almost every day.

This is the United States under Obama matching the lunacy of Europe, with the difference being Europe's revulsion at its own collapse and Obama's glee at empowering Iran, this generation's successor to Nazi Germany in its lunatic, bloody Jew-hatred.

What is going on in Europe and what is going on in the United States that has allowed this Muslim saboteur in the Oval Office come from the same failure of nerve and belief in the superiority of one's way of life when it is so clearly superior. Nothing to be ashamed of there. This invasion of people from Syria to Europe is evidence of their own voting for Europe as a superior place to live, without, of course, making the connection, these Muslims, between its prosperity and religious history as a Christian continent not a Muslim one.

Is there one Muslim state among 56 that a Westerner can say is superior to his country?

Yet to speak up as Hungary's Prime Minister Viktor Orban did, in speaking up for Christianity against Islam, is to invite the sneers of the Continent's Enlightened post-Christians.

Iran's defense minister in this interview also said that since WWII, the U.S. has "dedicated itself to causing conflict between nations, scandals and wars between the peoples of the world. The U.S. has overrun nations and plots everywhere."

As in Washington Harry Reid wants a filibuster to prevent discussion of Obama's plan to send all that money to Iran, the Iran that wants to destroy America and says so every day? What is going on there in Washington, D.C.?

The world is off its axis.

And where is the UN as today's Nazi Germany heads for the atomic bomb that the liar Obama said he would never let them have? I imagine he said that even more times than the 26 times he said, "If you like your doctor you can keep your doctor" when he knew he was lying.

The UN, in the midst of this river of humanity fleeing the horrors of the Muslim Middle East will be busy tomorrow on a resolution allowing non-member States at the UN to have their flags flown alongside that of member-states. Of course the mover and shaker on this resolution is the Balestinian Authority, this phantom national government that lives 100% on the dole, the creation of world antiJewry hiding behind

its love of the fictitious Palestinians allegedly victimized by the same people who murdered Jesus.

In a way, it's the PA's way, this resolution, of trying to invade the UN as Muslims are at this very moment pouring into Europe. Yes, the UN will be tomorrow will be lost in deep "religious" activity in voting to allow the PLO Jew-killers to fly their flag of a state that simply does not exist as other states do.

And in Brussels, I guess, they are working on polishing the text of a regulation requiring that a commodity/product produced in Judea and Samaria by Jews be so labeled, for the land on which it was produced was stolen by the Jews from the its ancient, authorized, internationally recognized Balestinian owners. These Europeans still have a long way to go before they confront the *sub rosa* antisemitism of this project.

The Israeli government is appealing to the EU and pointing out that such a regulation is not proposed for products produced in Turkish-occupied Cyprus or Morocco-occupied Sahara, and there surely must be other territories around the planet where sovereignty is in dispute. This singling out of Israel is blatantly unfair and therefore antisemitic.

It is almost as if Federica Mogherini the adolescent Communist and her camp are mockers of the Jewish notion of Chosenness. She does not see how she and her ilk choose us for special treatment that is plainly, manifestly unfair, especially in light of the easily-made case that Judea and Samaria are rightfully Israel's property, though on that score,

Federica and friends get a pass because official Israel never stakes that claim. Historians of the future will puzzle over this for generations to come.

We may, though, be at a turning point in the matter of the Arabs in Judea and Samaria due to the threat -- that official Israel does not take seriously -- of the Holocaust Denying murderer Dr. Abbas saying he is going to announce the end of Oslo when he speaks at the UN as he does before a packed house every fall.

He is talking this way, of course as a threat, to stop taking the millions of dollars and euros the Oslo Abomination sends his way? Yeah, sure.

I, for one, would welcome his cancelling of all the agreements, as he threatens to, because I have been nauseated by all of them for 23 years.

I remember how 1) I used to idolize Rabin and Peres and 2) because of that in 1993 and 1994 and even 1995 I could not accept what they were doing at face value. I believed, I wanted to believe, that it was all an immense deception. I remember how in 1995 when all the PLO big shots gathered in Gaza for a meeting, two years into the Oslo Peace Process that had already seen to many terrorist horrors, and thought, "This is it." They even let in some of the worst of the terror chieftains they had shunned as part of the peace process, judged to be far worse than Arafat with whom they shook hands with, to cross over the Jordan to attend the gathering. They were given a promise of safe passage to attend the historic vote, and I imagined that when all of them had reached their destination in Gaza and were all under the same roof, a flight of warplanes would fly over, drop their bombs, flatten the entire building and kill hundreds as surely as Samson in that very same Gaza brought down the Philistine temple on the heads of the Philistine leaders.

But no such luck. I am trying to say it took me two and more years to accept that what Rabin and Peres were doing was insane. I remember at the outset calling up Prime Minister Shamir's chief of staff who had hired me for the UN project to ask him, "Tell me, Yossi, is this some deep trick or have they gone completely crazy? And what he answered terrified me. He said, "Yes, they have gone completely crazy."

I was reminded of that today as I read of the speech that Meir Dagan gave yesterday at the annual conference in Herzliya run by the International Institute for Counter-Terrorism.

Dagan, you recall, was for a time head of the Mossad. Most of his adult life was in the IDF where he was famous for his own counter-terror raids and the liquidating of terrorists; let's call them extra-judicial executions. He and Arik Sharon were a team famous for that, for hunting them down in the orange groves in Gaza and doing what needed to be done.

Well, he in his speech, and not for the first time, attacked the prime minister for his handling of Iran. Dagan is reputed to have prevented Bibi, when head of the Mossad, from attacking Iran -- he would not give his approval which was needed -- when Bibi wanted to a few years back. Yesterday, he pooh-poohed the idea again. He also that Iran would never have a missile that can reach the US, which I find a profoundly stupid thing to say. For sure, he knows they have short-range missiles today and therefore have no need of

developing a long-range missile to the hit the U.S. You just launch one from the deck of an innocent commercial freighter that has sailed across the ocean and anchored off Chesapeake Bay.

There is more about Dagan I want to get to, but first some more music.

Yes, Meir Dagan, whom I interviewed some 25 years ago and was not impressed, attacked Bibi yesterday for not getting along with Obama. He went so far as to say that Israel made “a strategic decision to adopt a policy against the United States and it is time to end it.”

This is just foolish. Israel made it a strategic policy to go against the U.S? What for? He said the problem is Iran and not President Obama.

This is another case, I’m afraid, nowhere near the first, of an Israeli who simply does not know the American scene, does not know who Obama really is. He is not a leftist the way Dagan may view himself a leftist. Dagan also thinks Israel can live without the Jordan River as a border. Obama is not like Dagan who wants peace and believes Israel will have to abandon Judea and Samaria in order to secure it. Dagan just doesn’t get it that Obama is not a leftist but an antisemite who wants to see Israel destroyed, G-d forbid. Israelis on the left like him commonly don’t see this.

Dagan said “the policies that Netanyahu and Bennett are leading are going in a very problematic direction, both in the field of the Palestinian problem as well as in our relations with our great friend the United States.”

Again, Dagan, in speaking of “the Palestinian problem” here, exposes that he still doesn’t get it. There is no “Palestinian problem.” This has been nothing but a verbal smokescreen to cover up the real problem and that is “the Israeli problem.” The violence here has never been about the absence of a state for “Palestinians” but the presence of a state for Jews.

This is why he also yesterday sniffed at Bibi’s insistence that the PA must recognize Israel as a Jewish state. This is, he said, “nonsense.”

No, this is the heart of the matter. So long as the Muslims do not do that, they are presumptively as committed as ever to destroying Israel, G-d forbid, and in that circumstance Israel gives them nothing.

So I imagine that for Meir Dagan and his camp, the threat of Abbas to cancel, in his own words, “all agreements with Israel,” is a distressing prospect.

Yours truly, by contrast, would celebrate. If Abbas does this, when he declares the Oslo Accords a dead letter, this must include the Israeli commitment made at the time not to pursue Fatah leaders starting with Arafat and his sidekick Abbas and basically trick them into coming into Palestine where the IDF would pounce on them and arrest them as terrorist leaders. Oslo meant Israel giving its word not to do something like that.

So if Abbas does cancel Oslo, I think that not an hour should pass before an IDF force in sufficient strength invades Ramallah and goes right to this antisemitic, criminal enemy and arrests him in the name of the Jewish people and Western civilization as a whole. This bum was a party to innumerable terrorist atrocities and if he cancels Oslo, he cancels his own immunity. After therefore should be arrested, tried, convicted and executed. He and Erekat and Rajoub and Dahlan and the whole of lot of them. And if they should resist, they should be shot.

The Israeli interviewer called him a hero. He said, "No, I am not a hero. This is what every person should have done. I did it because I'm a human being. With all my heart, I am a man of peace." He said he had been afraid at the moment that men in ski masks would show up and give us trouble, when the boys were inside. "But I knew I would defend them even if it risked my life and the lives of my children." He also showed a machete that he keeps near the door in case of trouble.
