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Transcript

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Shalom laYehudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim. It's the evening of the 6th day, *kaf-zion beElul, Parashas Nitzavim*, the evening of the 5th day, Thursday, 10 September 2015, webcasting from clueless Israel once again.

I mean, really, Israelis have to wake up. Here are the first five sentences of a late-breaking story today reported by the Times of Israel website. "Israel's Foreign Ministry came out swinging Thursday after the European Parliament passed a resolution that advocated a distinction between Israel and its West Bank settlements, and the labeling of settlement produce.

"Lawmakers had called earlier in the day for the 'differentiation between Israel and its activities in the occupied Palestinian Territory, and encouraged EU foreign policy chief Federica Mogherini to take the lead...completing the work of EU-wide guidelines on the labeling of Israeli settlement produce.'

"Israel's Foreign Ministry lashed out against the EU in a scathing response calling it 'discriminatory and reeking of boycott. Under the guise of a technical procedure, it's an attempt to force a diplomatic solution, instead of encouraging the Palestinians to return to negotiations...Europe treats Israel with sanctimonious hypocrisy when it doesn't raise the issue of similar situations in Northern Cyprus and Western Sahara.'"

And I say, when are Israelis going to understand that so long as they continue to use the language, the lexicon that they do, the Europeans will continue to act the way they do?

Journalist Tamar Pileggi wrote that lede sentence. Listen again “...the Foreign Ministry came out swinging after the European Parliament advocated making a distinction between Israel and the West Bank settlements.”

Dearest Tamar, so long as you and Israelis, especially in the Foreign Ministry use the terms “West Bank” and “settlements,” the Europeans will act as they do. Israel has also never claimed the “West Bank,” and Israel has admitted that much of the “West Bank” should belong to the Ancient Ones, and uses the term “settlements,” as she and the government do, the Europeans will behave as they do.

At Auschwitz, the Germans turned living Jews into objects; more precisely, into animals, like cattle, diseased cattle, that must be destroyed. And being Germans, *Ordnung muss sein*/there must be order, they registered every one and like branding an animal they burnt numbers into their forearms, serial numbers that replaced the names their parents had given them. So the covering up of Judea and Samaria with the term “West Bank,” makes of “West Bank” an antisemitic expression that no self-respecting Jew should ever use.

And Tamar, when you call the Jewish communities in Judea and Samaria “settlements,” you connote newness and therefore something that can easily be removed.

You would be amazed how many post-Jewish Israelis have never crossed the 1949 cease-fire lines in any but the most superficial way, and they envision the “settlements” as clusters of leaky caravans. They don’t think of Kiryat Arba with its small apartment houses; of Efrat with its tens of thousands of people in private homes and apartment houses; they don’t think of Maaleh Adumim with its scores of thousands, and Ariel too, and all the neighborhoods in Jerusalem that did not exist before 1967, people in apartment houses. One of Jerusalem’s first acts after unification was drawing the new city limits of Greater Jerusalem.

Because Tamar Pileggi and the Foreign Ministry use this vocabulary, they get the behavior they do. Israel has never demanded its rights to this real estate. Israel has agreed there should be a Balestinian state on it, boundaries to be determined, so what does she and the Foreign Ministry want from the Europeans who via their labeling are confirming Israel’s view this land really belongs to and should be handed to its rightful, ancient owners? In this light, there is something not kosher about Israelis living on land they admit is not theirs and doing business on this land, making money on this land.

As Caesar Chavez was a darling of left in the 1960s in California representing grape workers and calling for a grape boycott because the wages were intolerably low, so the Europeans see themselves in support of the victims of this Israeli refusal to evacuate land that does not belong to it and stop doing business on land that it admits is not Israel’s.

Notice, too, that the Foreign Ministry uses the term “discriminatory” but not “antisemitism,” even as yesterday in London, Prime Minister Netanyahu went to 10

Downing Street and was met by a heckling crowd ostensibly “pro-Palestinian” but just naked antisemites. Judging by the news reports, the pro-Israel counter-demonstrators were not expecting what they witnessed: out and out hatred of Jews. Yesterday, I saw one woman in a video there smiling and shrugging as she seemed to call for a new Holocaust and the extermination of today’s six million Jews here.

What I am getting at is that Israel has to wake up to the truth the hostility to this state is not due to the love of any ancient people whose entire land was stolen by the Jews us. No, it is old-fashioned, timeless Jew-hatred which has existed in every generation, albeit in ever-mutating forms and really disguises.

In early 19th century Germany, intellectuals tried to begin thinking about Jew-hatred scientifically since they had lost faith in religion. Once one drops the belief in Jesus of Nazareth as a divine being, out goes the deicide charge; you can’t hate Jews any more for that reason. One idea was that people hate Jews because that they smell differently. There is a certain Jewish odor and people were put off by that peculiar smell, and one reason one intellectual said was that they eat too many onions and garlic.

Another tried to connect the smell to peculiar sexual practices that the Jewish religion calls for.

Five hundred years earlier, in the 14th century, in Germany, the Jews were said to have poisoned the wells when the Black Death took away a third of Europe, and in retribution for this evil activity by the Jews, they were massacred in many locales.

Today in Europe, it is the presence of these “settlements” by Jews on land that does not belong to them that rouses opposition. Hence the labelling of products from this stolen land.

Worse, today, I guess in Strasbourg when Euro-Parliament usually meets, the men and passed another resolution – who knows how many against Israel they have passed over the years? -- calling for a greater role for themselves in determining the fate and future of Palestine and deliberately refused to include an amendment calling for renewed Israeli-Balestinian negotiations toward the two-state solution, which analysts say smells of rejecting the idea of two states for two peoples. By implication, they were calling for the real, final solution of one state for both peoples that means transforming Israel into a non-specific state. The Middle East will go from its current 21 Arab states vs. 1 Jewish state to 21 Arab-states and a neutered, binational state in which of course over time, and not much time, the Ancient Palestinians will have more children than the Jews and turn it into a 22nd Arab state with a Jewish minority. That means the end of Zionism.

Arutz Sheva reported that one parliamentarian spoke out against this amendment including the two-state solution for that could lead to the “ethnic cleansing of the non-Jewish population.”

You got that? He fears creating two states for two peoples would recognize Israel as a Jewish state and could lead to the Jews licensing themselves to drive the Arabs out of Israel into the new Balestinian state or someplace else.

Israelis have to wake up and see through the taurine excreta embodied in the terms of reference “West Bank,” “Palestinians” and “settlements.”

Israel must launch a campaign in the country and abroad insisting that the expression “West Bank” in Israel is as offensive as the N word in English. Israel should shout to the heavens that there is no “West Bank.” No maps of this land for centuries display anything but the names Judea and Samaria, Judea the source of the word “Jew.” A Jew, an Israeli, who does not use that term is a Jew with a problem, a psychological problem, from the Greek for soul. A Jew who does not say “Judea” is a Jew with a problem in his soul.

Yes, Israelis must wake up and see the connection between events in the European Parliament to and yesterday, in front of 10 Downing Street, and in Manchester last week and Holland last month. All are different facets of Jew-hatred in our time.

I don’t know about you, but all my post-WWII life, I assumed that the world had assimilated the insanity of antisemitism because of that War and we would not see it again.

I was wrong. To be honest, HaShem has not allowed the goyim thus far to go crazy *en masse* as in the past. The number of incidents against Jews is by comparison incredibly small in our time and there is no government fanning the flames except the Muslim ones. Still, on the micro level, we are witness to homicidal violence against Jews in individual cases which is as horrifying as any in our history. It is timeless violence.

Maybe you saw the report of that old Jewish couple in Holland. She is 86, her husband is 87, Samuel and Diana Blug, whose home was broken into one night last month by probably Moroccans who demanded all their valuables and beat them bloody, literally crippling them. They are in wheelchairs in a hospital or long-term care facility. The pictures on the net of this old woman black and blues bruised in the face, battered, were horrific. And I say those who did this to them are timeless, criminal, homicidal Jew-haters as monstrous as any Nazi, any Roman Centurion, any Cossack, Polish or Spanish Catholic priest in a drunken rampage. What Muslims did in Paris to Ilan Halimi a few years back was nothing new in the history our people. They tortured him to death over a two-week period of Hell on earth.

In Uman, Ukraine, just last Shabbos, the local goyim wrecked a tent city Jews use for the pilgrimage to the grave of Rebbe Nachman of Breslau on Rosh Hashanah.

In Manchester last Motzei Shabbos, a Jewish 17 year-old, son of a rabbi, reportedly buying weed, apparently rubbed the dealer the wrong way that gave him and his confederates reason to beat him bloody. He has been a coma since. Bleeding in the brain. It is a fair bet that the fact of Jewishness played a major role in the violence he suffered.

Reported today as we approach the end of 5775 was a serious uptick in immigration last year over the year before, and for sure the new *olim* were heavily from Europe. In the JPost report, a Jewish activist in Belgium, one Joel Rubinfeld said, “I fear we are witnessing

the last generation of a significant European Jewish community as, at age 18, more and more young European Jews are leaving their countries mainly to Israel, the U.S. and Canada as they feel they have no more future in Europe as a Jew.”

I'll say. Especially this week as we see the floodgates open in Europe to the invasion of ultimately more than a million Muslims. So young Jewish men and women who are awake, sober and intelligent know what is happening and it all bad news, big time, because Muslims feel about Jews today like, say, Roman Catholics in the 14th century when the Black Death struck down millions.

Think of it this way: Christianity was in its seventh century when Islam emerged and produced its first book. That is how primitive these illiterate, rock-worshipping Arab savages were at the time. European literacy can be traced back to the Homeric period more than thousand years before the rise of Islam. And of course we Jews had been reading the *Torah miSinai* for almost two thousand year before the Arabs produced their first book, the Koran.

And so, in a simple, arithmetic sense, we can say Islam started life seven centuries after the Christian era began and it has remained at least seven centuries behind in civilizational development, which is why I say that what is for Jews and Christians the 21st century, it is the 14th for the Arabs, a people as savage in their physical cruelty these days with their head-chopping and sadistic tortures, as Europeans were back then.

Rubinfeld is surely correct in his prophecy. This is the last generation of Jewish life in Europe because at this moment these Muslim barbarians are invading. Let me correct that: They are not invading anymore; they are being invited to invade by the Europeans who have got to know at some level of intelligence that they are committing suicide.

Actually, judging by some worthy analysts, this move by the Germans in particular in welcoming all these Muslims may be less attempted suicide than an attempt to survive. The birthrate there for decades has been so low, the Germans literally are going out of existence. They are going the way of the, I don't know, the Etruscans and the Visigoths, the Alans and the Lombards, etc.

How else to explain this seeming lunacy of an Angela Merkel who just a few years ago said integration had failed? Why is she doing this?

We seem to be living in a time when the great tectonic plates of civilization and history are shifting. A thousand years ago, the nation states we are all familiar with in Europe did not exist. There was no Germany or Italy. They did not congeal as unitary nations until the 1870s. France into the 20th century was home to a population twenty percent of whom did not speak Parisian French but the provincial languages of Bretagne in the north and Provençal in the south

Where are the Celts and the Druids? Excepting us Jews, nations come and nations go, and I think we are witness to something like that now.

And not surprisingly, one feature of national turmoil that keeps popping up in such times is a rise in Jew-hatred, the eternal nation that does not disappear.

In 1848 in Europe, called the Springs of Nation -- forerunner and inspiration for Little Tommy Friedman's delusional Arab Spring -- peoples defined by their languages and the variety of church under the Hapsburg Empire, rose up. Nationalism was in the air; these peoples wanted their independence, and not surprisingly the Jews were targets in Germany, no less, as a result of which, in the space of ten years, a quarter-million Jews fled for the States into the Wild West. Unlike the latter-day, Yiddish-speaking Eastern European and Russian Jews who got off the boat at Ellis Island and plopped down right there in Manhattan, or made their way to Chicago or Philadelphia and other big cities, those German Jews literally walked into the American interior. They did not stay in the big cities. They went out as peddlers with notions to sell, and when their store of goods ran out, they opened a store in a town or in the new, burgeoning new cities, and then went on to build the first department stores in the States. Macy's, Gimbels, Marshall Field, I. Magnin, Filene's Basement, Neiman-Marcus, Alexander's, B. Altman, Bloomingdales, Sears-Roebuck. Such was the energy of these German Jews who fled Germany a century before the Holocaust due to the flowering of evil Jew-hatred in Germany in their lifetimes.

So Germany and Europe are once again, not for the first, experiencing an uptick in frightening Jew-hatred expressed in varying degrees of civility from the European Parliament to the mean streets of London and Manchester.

This invasion by these millions of Muslims, six million already are in Germany and, another 800,000 are expected this year, may indeed be a desperate grab for survival by the Germans.

Then again, one cannot help but note the oddity, the weird coincidence if that is the word, of the German's today ushering in a culture as hateful of Jews as German culture down the centuries has been. As we just heard in the last segment, before the Holocaust of the 20th century in Germany, it was antisemitic in the 19th century during the early flowering of the lunatic theories of anti-Semites.

It was also there during the Crusades of the 11th and 12th centuries when the Jewish communities in Worms, Speyer and Mainz were satanically pogrommed. In Martin Luther's 16th century, the Jews were target as well. To read Luther on the Jews is to listen to a soulmate of a 20th century Nazi crackpot.

There is also fear in Europe today that within this river of humanity streaming from Syria, Iraq, Afghanistan, etc., there will no shortage of homicidal maniacs primed to murder Jews, beat them up as that poor couple in Holland was beaten. There is a fear ISIS head choppers will also come back from the battlefield and attack Jewish institutions and Israeli businesses.

The excellent Gatestone website today ran a piece on how Germany is already, and has been for a while, instituting in some schools courses on Islam, mandatory for all pupils, where the curriculum is being designed by jihadis.

We know how in France and England for some years now public education has been silent on the Holocaust because it offends Muslim sensibilities, for according to Islam in our time, the Holocaust never happened. It is Jewish propaganda, and the Muslims have protested when the Brits and the French have taught the subject in their public schools.

Thus does Europe commit suicide and simultaneously turn the Continent over to this generation's leading Jew-hating faith community, who are as flakey about Jews as Germans were in their Nazi phase. The Nazis with their crackpot theories and hallucinations of Jewish skullduggery were simply bonkers and so are today's Muslims.

Europe is committing demographic suicide via abortion, birth control, pornography which leads to the spilling of seed, as sodomy does and is even blessed by the culture these days. That is why they are disappearing.

And in its place come these 7th century primitives. One imagines that Angela Merkel and her fellow German leaders in their desperation hope to be able to Germanize all these Muslims, though she herself admitted that has not happened since Germany began importing Turks as *gastarbeiter*/guest workers in the 50s and 60s to make up for the shortfall in manpower due to the eight million Germans who died during WWII. The very definition of what it means to be a German or a Frenchman is being challenged and chipped away from inside and mutating away from a moribund Christian identity toward an Islam still on fire with belief in its right to take over, like Nazis, the whole world.

Lastly, to end the week and the year on an up note in the midst of all these stories of violence against Jews, which include the firebombing fad in Jerusalem that has been going on for some weeks now in neighborhoods abutting Arab areas like Armon HaNatziv and Abu Tor.

Defense Minister Yaalon has also in writing outlawed two Arab groups paid by jihadis to harass Jews on the Temple Mount. It has been bad enough for years now that Jews can only visit, not pray; now they can barely think because they are routinely surrounded by shrieking females, with the police doing their damndest not to let the Jews offend these Arabs. Apparently, Yaalon thinks the police can prevent these harpies in the future from their ugly behavior.

Separately, State Attorney Shai Nitzan yesterday ordered all prosecutors to seek stiffer penalties for rock-throwers. On the one hand, that's good news; on the other, his initiative will not apply to those who throw rocks at our soldiers, only civilians.

Well, I suppose it is a step forward. As I said the other day, the cliché tells us that if you want respect, you must first respect yourself, and Israel can start by banning the rock-

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throwers and the use of the words, “West Bank” and “settlements,” and start using the names “Judea” and “Samaria” and speak of our “rights.”
