*Shalom laYehudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim.* It is the evening of the 6th day, *kaf-dales beMar Heshvan, Parashas Khayei Sarah, tav-shin-ayin-vav*, the evening of the 5th day, Thursday, 5 November 2015, webcasting from "Kill the Jew Central."

There was another attempt this afternoon at the ever-popular Gush Etzion intersection now crawling with soldiers. Two of them picked up the scent, if you will, of an Arabian approaching with evil intent, who when spotted whipped out a knife and charged and these Israelite warriors, as they used to say in the Old Wild West, "plugged the varmint" with their assault rifles. Shot him dead.

Other than that, the good news in the newspapers this morning was the removal of some temporary barricades in the Arab section of Jerusalem because there has been only one Jew-killing attempt in the last two weeks.

I have a hunch that this is the way it will be for the foreseeable future: sort of like a heart expanding and contracting, the beat, the pulse of life; the horde of Ishmaelites in the city will periodically be calm, then periodically erupt in a pent-up need to spill Jewish blood and experience the exquisite, physical pleasure of plunging a blade into a Jewish body. Even if you don't kill the Jew, you experience the tactile thrill of sinking that knife into Jewish flesh. And if you're lucky, you get to see the warm Jewish blood spurt out.

These are our neighbors, a nation with a truly pathological percentage of psychopaths. Indeed, not just a pathological excess of them and tolerance for them but a celebration of them.

I mean, every culture has its psychopaths; its serial killers, its conscienceless murderers, cold-blooded killers. The difference, then, between humane societies on the one hand, and inhuman, animal-like cultures is not the existence of psychopaths but how the larger community relates to them. In civilized society, a man goes “postal,” massacres a bunch of co-workers, G-d forbid, and the instantaneous response of the civilized is, “That guy is insane, he’s crazy, he’s off his rocker.”

Among barbarians, by contrast, like our neighbors, the psychopath is a national hero after whom streets and schools are named. You know that demon who on Succot stabbed those two rabbis to death in the Old City, and plunged a knife into the neck of the wife of one of them and wounded her baby boy, has already been honored in some way by the great white hope of the Enlightened, Dr. Abbas, the noted historian. He named a park or school or an athletic competition after him.

So we had today a Jew-killing attempt that failed and yesterday an attempt that almost succeeded. Not far from the Gush Etzion intersection on the way to Hevron, a Border Guard was run over by any Arabian in a vehicle who was in turn shot dead by the soldier’s comrades-in-arms. The Border Guard this evening is fighting for his life, seriously broken up.

In other security news stories yesterday, the Al-Aqsa preacher mentioned on this webcast recently, Sheikh Khaled al-Mugrabi, was arrested for his incendiary sermons in which he has, *inter alia*, said, “The *Bani Israel*/the sons of Israel will all be killed.”

I wish the ruling class here did more in the way of public diplomacy not by periodically whining how much “Israel wants a Balestinian state but the Ancient Ones won’t cooperate with us” but shining a powerful searchlight on this man and others to expose to the world what lunatic, evil people these Muslim preachers are in a class with any lunatic Nazi spouting insane Jew-hatred last century. These Arabs are as crazy about Jews as any German ever was.

The younger generation of Jews on college campuses in the West these days, if they are not Orthodox, are woefully ill equipped to understand what is happening, and Israel, I am afraid, is of little help.

Ministress Tsipi Hotovely was off to Europe this week to persuade the EU that boycotting Israeli-owned businesses in Judea and Samaria will hurt tens of thousands of so-called “Palestinians.” What young Tsipi, born and raised in Israel, does not understand is that the Europeans she is speaking to don’t give a rodent’s hindquarters about these so-called Palestinians. None of their supporters in the West really care about their “plight”. It is just this generation’s vessel or *keli* in Hebrew for “legitimate” Jew-hatred.

In every generation, hating Jews has been legitimate for one reason or another. Some of these accusation have a long shelf life, like the decide charge, but some are passing phenomena. What unites all the different styles, though, is belief in the Jews

committing some terrible crime that justifies the hatred and reacting to them most violently.

A friend was telling me the other day, a mechanic here, that one of the otherwise pleasant Arab suppliers he deals with in Yosh was on a tear the other day as he was buying some supplies from him, bashing Israelis like him for stealing Palestine, for harming Al-Aqsa, for murdering boys, for stealing land and so on and so forth.

I mean, consider the anger of that Ishmael-clone today with a knife in hand at the Gush Etzion junction. He must have been one angry, enraged, cauldron of homicidal hatred, and for sure in his own mind he was bent on a righteous act. The Jews are agents of Satan in his community, and what could be holier and more heroic than killing an agent of Satan?

So I wish official Israel would go on the offensive and stop being so defensive like the otherwise estimable Tsipi Hotovely appealing to the Europeans in the name of the Ancient Ones.

What Israel has to do is rebrand these people for the barbaric soulmates of Al-Qaeda that they are. These knife boys bent on homicide as well suicide are soulmates of the sky devils on 9-11, bent on murder and suicide too. And why? Because their targets, in both cases, are enemies of Islam. I have no doubt in my mind that Osama bin Ladin, that truly primitive homo sapiens who wore the cloth robes of his illiterate and uncivilized Arab ancestors, thought that the World Trade Center was just that: not a complex of city office buildings where all kinds of businesses rented space but in truth the Center of World Trade, where all the levers of power were in the hands of Jews in New York, that most populous Jewish city in the world. To destroy the World Trade Center was to destroy world trade dominated by the Jews.

This is with whom we are dealing, but Israel is still tragically mired in its Herzlian aspiration to make peace and become friends with our Arab neighbors. And I say, as an observer of the Arabs, they can't make peace among themselves but with us Jews they are just ripe for a friendly, collaborative, peaceful relationship, you know "two states for two peoples"? Yeah right.

In my book's first chapter, I show how even that last phrase is a dishonest expression in more than one way. First, in the Arab-Israeli conflict, there are 21 Arab states and 1 Jewish state. That's 22 states for 2 peoples. Secondly, in historical fact, the classical map of Palestine is today divided into four parts, three of them officially Arab, one of them officially Jewish, with the three Arab states in possession of more than half of Palestine. Israel should make the case that if and when the three Arab states, Lebanon, Syria and Jordan, in possession of 53% of classical Palestine want to hand it over to Mahmoud Abbas and his feral community to create a state for the Balestinians that they pretend to care so much about, Israel would not stop them.

Israel is its own worst enemy in trying to make nice to the Arabs and to the EU. Israel must demand its rights (!) and shatter the false and dishonest claims of our

brutal and brutish enemies with their ridiculous perversions of history and even current events.

How ironic. The Oslo Delirium initiated 22 years and 2 months ago was very much, for post-Jewish, post-Zionist Israelis, the end of our isolation. One artifact of that delirium was the still and disgusting Israeli affection these days of saying “Hi” and “Bye” instead of the classical “Shalom.” Oslo was about becoming just like everybody else.

But this has brought on only terror the likes of which we never knew before and hatred from the goyim unknown in the first decades of the state.

Perhaps, then, by reversing course, taking a different tack, we will get a different and positive response. No more Mr. Nice Guy pining for peace with the “victims” of our national movement.

These Arabs here are the same Arab Muslims who brought down the World Trade and with them we make no deals if only because as outlaw barbarians, they never keep them.

Well, the labelling story, as mentioned before, remains a top issue here. Yesterday, Michael Oren, former ambassador to the U.S., went to, I think, the small supermarket in the so-called Germany Colony in Jerusalem, with a photographer to be photographed placing stickers imprinted with “Made in Europe” on various products in a media event to protest against what he sees as the antisemitism of the EU sanctioning us this way because, in his eyes, the EU is looking away from other countries such as China and Turkey and Morocco in questionable possession of allegedly another people’s land.

I agree. This is more evidence of the antisemitism of the Europeans today who are descended from generations of anti-Jews. This double standard is an indication of their twisted souls.

But like other non-religious Jews, Oren misses the religious dimension of the hostility of these Europeans. They are like Obama who, you may have noticed, has dropped the Ancient Ones as a crusade because he never did care about them. Having achieved his greatest goal as president -- stabbing Israel in the back by protecting Iran in its drive to build atomic weapons -- so the Europeans don’t care about these Arabs either. Unlike earlier generations, they no longer accuse Jews of being Christ-killers; they can’t because they are no longer Christians themselves. No one is dying as well in the Bubonic Plague in Europe, so the Jews cannot be held accountable for that. It is for our base, criminal theft of Balaam from its authentic owners that licenses Europeans to aggress against us.

It is a toss-up as to the greater event in Jewish history: either the declaration of independence in 1948 and the creation of the state or the victory in 1967 when, unlike

1948, Israel finally came into possession of the Temple Mount and Judea and Hebron and Shilo, the heart of the heart of the Biblical saga of the Jewish people.

Today, Europeans are not only post-religious, they are post-national and as such envy the Jews for remaining loyal to our national identity which is also a religious identity. There is a double envy here of the Jews as a people that retains its national identity and, no less, continues to practice its religion, when Europe's churches are empty and nationalism out of favor.

Worse, hatred of the Jews is rooted in the oldest of human behaviors: Adam and Eve's rebellion against G-d. The existence of the Jews over thousands of years as still not only a living people but a thriving one, still pioneers in science and technology and medicine, rattles the antiJew who is eternally at war with the G-d of All That Is. The thriving existence of this people and its return home after 18 centuries of terrible abuse in exile makes people begin to suspect that maybe there is something to their belief in this G-d Who really exists. A lot of people don't want to know that.

Not the National Socialists like their pagan leader Adolf Hitler who wanted to restore the pre-Christian pantheon of German folklore; not the Marxists whose ideology begins in atheism. In the Soviet Union, the official "religion" was atheism and was taught in public schools. Instead of "superstitious" religion, the Soviets taught their kids about Scientific Socialism, their ideology.

And then there is that third totalitarian system still alive and kicking, unfortunately, Islam, which is nothing but Yiddishkeit purloined and perverted. Muslims simply cannot accept Jewishness if only because it teaches that their forefather Ishmael was a wild ass of a man and certainly not his father's favorite.

Like Cain whose jealousy of his kid brother for presenting G-d with a better gift, Ishmael cannot tolerate the reality that his half-brother was a better man than he was.

Ishmael as a wild ass in his essence was like a carnivorous animal thirsty for blood --like the Ishmaelite today with knife in hand who was, fortunately, slain by the guardians of the Jewish people.

So hats off to Michael Oren for highlighting the obvious unfairness of the EU for singling out Israel for sanctions when other nations in similar situations are left alone.

Oren, like Tsipi Hotovely, spoke to the media in that supermarket about the loss of hundreds of jobs for what he called the Palestinians employed in Jewish-owned businesses in Judea and Samaria, as if anybody but the employees themselves care about their pending unemployment, if it comes to that.

Actually, I sent off a letter to JPost today regarding this matter. I had my first op-ed published by them this week (more on that in a moment) but this letter was about the labelling problem and what to do about it. This is what I wrote:

"The EU is absolutely right that what they call the 'West Bank' is not part of Israel primarily because Israel itself has never officially claimed it and that Jews have the right to live in it peacefully.

“Jerusalem was legally reunited within two weeks of the Six-Day War; and in 1981, the Golan plateau was formally annexed.

“But never the ‘West Bank.’ It remains under the same military law today that it was in June 1967 due to an Israeli dream as old as the Allon Plan proposed that July to ‘sell back’ some (!) of the land overrun in 1967 to the Arabs who will turn it into a fourth, independent Arab state in the region with a piece of classical Palestine. Israel would keep the rest; peace would reign, and the Arabs would become our good friends and contented neighbors.

“The EU is right that the ‘West Bank’ is not part of Israel, but a solution is possible. Unlike the Arabs in 1947 who rejected UNGA Res. 181, the Partition Plan, today they demand a state based upon it, so let’s use the language therein. In those days, the name “West Bank” had yet to be coined. But there was a reference to ‘Samaria and Judea.’

“So if the EU cannot stomach a label marked, “Made in Israel,” how’s about ‘Made in Judea and Samaria’? “

Yes, as I mentioned before that Benayoun music that I like so much, I had my first submission of an op-ed published after a half-dozen rejections. And I’m pretty sure why that was so, why I was finally published.

I did not place at the end of the submission my standard bio these days which is, “Sha’i ben-Tekoa’s *Phantom Nation: Inventing the “Palestinians” as the Obstacle* is available on Amazon.com.”

Therefore I was published. That title does not sit well with the Jerusalem Post, I am sure, which remains what I call a “West Bank” newspaper because that is how it refers to Judea and Samaria.

I think I’ve mentioned that once it had a very good weekend magazine but now has a new editor whose is very big on human-interest stories among the Balestinians and stories about sodomites with occasional pieces by a female Reform rabbi, when the Reform have no statistically significant presence in Israel. This Reform rabbi is the sister of the utterly talentless comedienne Sarah Silverman whose act is nothing but spewing dirty words. For this she elicits nervous laughter which is not real laughter and wit. Without her stream of obscenities uttered so sweetly, she has no talent. And this is her sister, this Reform rabbi living in Jerusalem who has an occasional pulpit now in the Jerusalem Post Magazine to bash classical Jewishness.

So I decided this time not to send my submission with my book’s shockingly incorrect, powerful title and the subversive of conventional wisdom subtitle. And, *voila*, the article was in the paper yesterday.

It is my response to the latest opinionator in the paper who in his response to Netanyahu’s unfortunate remarks about Haj Amin al-Husseini and Hitler, wrote, as

Caroline Glick often does, that the Grand Mufti was the “father of Palestinian Nationalism.” My piece was entitled, “Haj Amin was no Palestinian nationalist.”

I laid out some facts to make my case, and gently ended with the statement that Palestinian Nationalism was invented as verbal camouflage to cover up the hostility to Jewish freedom that is as old as the religion of Islam itself.

Maybe tomorrow there will be some protest letters against my “hatred” of the Palestinians for implying that their national identity is a sham.

Last item: The IDF on Tuesday shut down the crossing, the checkpoint, near Jenin where on a normal, quiet day thousands of workers pass through to jobs in Israel, and Israeli trucks and even thousands of Israeli Arabs pass through in the other direction to buy and shop, sell and work.

It was shut down on Tuesday after an Ishmaelite was caught with a bomb and a knife on him. In the last two weeks, there have been three attempted knife attacks against Israeli personnel who administer that crossing.

And what came to mind was the size of this traffic in both directions and the huge number of Ancient Ones working in Israel on a daily basis like this, which calls to mind the age of the Judges when the Children of Israel did not follow through on the command of their G-d not to make deals with the locals but to expel them. It says in the Torah that by allowing them to remain, they would become “thorns in your side and pricks in your eyes.” What HaShem did not want was what the Israelites did: to employ them and probably at wages below what an Israelite worker would merit.

And the result: Over 440 years when these goyim were allowed to stay and work, they would periodically rise up, attack and torment the Israelites until they could not take it anymore and cried out to G-d to send a new champion, a new Judge to drive them back.

It happened eleven times over 440 years in this cycle of Jews giving into the temptation to employ the Hamites -- and be corrupted and attacked by them in the process.

I think we are living in a similar time. So long as we continue to employ and exploit these people – in our own terms if not theirs --- we will suffer from them periodically. There were 11 Judges in those days over five centuries of cyclical behavior. HaShem, I think, wants Jewish labor working under Jewish management to keep management fair and honest.
