Shalom laYehudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim. It is the evening of the 6th day, *yud-bes beIyyar, Parashas BeHar, tav-shin-ayin-vav*, the evening of the 5th day, Thursday, 19 May 2016, webcasting from Israel, the extraordinary little country, extraordinarily productive in science, medicine, the arts and extraordinarily annoying in its political life.

So the top story in Israel today was the surprise shuffling of the ministers by the prime minister. Bogie out, Yvette Lieberman in at defense, or security as we say in Hebrew. Boojie was exposed as a stalking horse perhaps in all of this talk, a false front.

It also was rumored that in this jockeying for the insertion of the old Labor Party currently costumed as the Zionist Union into the government, there was maneuvering abroad in the US and England and Egypt, al-Sisi and Tony Blair and who knows who else, John Kerry (?) all jockeying that led to a statement by al-Sisi in Egypt with the word “peace” in it, which sent shivers up and down leftist spines and legs. Al-Sisi evidently thought it would help to have the leader of the opposition in Israel, Boojie, in the government. These fools abroad think that the thing to do to improve relations with the Arabs is give them more land, even a lot of land. Boojie stands for that, and the Arabs will be happy and content and stop threatening us and morph into friendly, smiling neighbors. That is what Kerry, Blair and al-Sisi think.

The upside for the prime minister is that he will now have 67 mandates instead of 61, which strengthens him against his in-house rival Naftali Bennett.

People are of course dubious that Lieberman, given his career, will know better how to manage the defense establishment than the distinguished Bogie Yaalon, the career soldier.

But maybe it doesn't matter. One presumes Bibi sees himself as final arbiter of all important decisions, so let Lieberman have his office and chauffeur and call himself Minister of Defense. The defense industries and the army pretty much run themselves.

I just hate these periodic episodes of reshuffling cabinet ministers and parties, a business that has no discernible impact on what's important here.

Of course the immediate top story during the day, besides this domestic one, was, apparently, yet another commercial airliner blown out of the sky. An EgyptAir flight, Paris to Cairo, 76 souls extinguished and the presumption at the highest level of the United States government, for sure, is that those responsible are likely "violent extremists." Whatever their nationality and their religion may be is, for the President of the United States of America, irrelevant, a distraction. And I think there even is in the Obama administration a department called CVE, a program to Counter Violent Extremists, I'm not kidding.

But extremist about what? What exactly these "violent extremists" are being extreme about the president never says.

The simple answer is Islam, their religion. They are so sure that they are the Chosen People by Allah, who wants everybody in the world to recognize that. And those who refuse can have their heads chopped off by Believers. That is how many Muslims feel about their religion, which tells them that Allah wants them to overrun the whole world and convert everybody to Islam and those who refuse will have their heads chopped off.

One imagines this is the extremism that Obama has in mind but won't say. He loves Islam too much, to such an extent that when they justify kidnapping women and boys and girls as slaves, he doesn't open his mouth.

And because this wicked man Obama is a lover of Islam, he has conducted his foreign policy accordingly. He has been functionally an Iranian agent the White House.

So another airliner was blown out of the sky over the Mediterranean Sea today. It is not the first. My book records a bunch of incidents like this in the 1970s and 80s; airliners blown out of the sky by Muslims, mostly Arabs.

My first guess is that it is ISIS as it was last October when a Russian plane load of vacationers were blown to their deaths over Sinai. The Egyptian tourism business in Sinai took a terrible hit, which was the purpose of the bombing. Revenge against Egypt for hunting ISIS devotees in the Sinai wilderness and in Egypt proper who are killing Egyptian policemen and soldiers.

And I find it all kind of ironic -- which may be a secular of way of expressing the presence of HaShem in history. Since the fictitious Arab Spring of 2011, the Arabs

have been slaughtering one another all over the place and it hardly is the first time. Since World War II, I've lost track of the times the Arabs in North Yemen have tried to unite with the Arabs in South Yemen that have produced transitory governments that all eventually came apart and the two parties started fighting again. They are always fighting in Yemen.

Libya never was a nation, just tribesmen. Under King Idris and later Gaddafi, all the skilled labor in Libya was Egyptian and Tunisians, because the locals were so backward. Gaddafi himself was born in a tent.

Egypt is about the only Arab country with a serious national identity, thanks to not Islam but pre-Islamic, Pharaonic Egypt. The Egyptians are not Arabs and many take pride in that.

But for the rest, not only do the Arabs remain sub-national in their societies, so are their ethics those of uncivilized barbaric people who think nothing of blowing up commercial airplanes carrying innocent people.

What the airline industry must do worldwide, as a first step, I think, is to fire all Muslims working in airports. More than once such employees have been implicated in planting these bombs. So responsible governments have to get rid of them, and let the civil liberties types take these governments to court afterwards and have that process drag out for years. Reality must be faced that innocent, civilian air travel has become the target of Muslims. And, notice, I don't say "Radical Muslims" or "Muslim extremists." Just Muslims, who are never criticized by the highest Muslims in the Muslim world, like the preachers at Al-Azhar.

These people have become a cancer on the world community. A domestic story in the US these days is that the TSA, you know, those people who grope you at the airport, does not have enough personnel to meet the demand of the tourist season now starting so it can take three hours to go through security.

I just in April took some flights in the States and stood in line and stood in awe of the power the sons of Ishmael to so afflict mankind. I mean, what are dealing with here if not the contemporary Arab-Muslim penchant for attacking innocent travelers just like Barbary Pirates of yesteryear? Preying on people in transit.

I stood in those security lines and went through the whole dance. And it is a dance of removing your shoes, belt, money, wallet, whatever is in your pockets, coins, laptop from its case, passing through the machine, sometimes getting frisked, at least and maybe twice sexually assaulted, and all because of these damned Arabs and Muslims who have made air travel such a pain.

There is irony, and perhaps the hand of G-d, in pondering these recent bombings of airliners, or that Malaysian hijacking in 2014 by a suicide pilot. Maybe it is all payback for all the attacks Muslims have visited on Israel and the West since the 1960s and 70s.

What EgyptAir is going to have to do now, if they can swallow their pride, is turn to Israel and ask for advice on how to secure their airplanes as the Israeli government does for El Al. Egypt has been at peace with Israel since 1979 but before then it was a major base and player for the PLO terror cults that bled us in Israel. They are now getting a taste of their own medicine, or so it seems. Having blessed and financed and assisted the PLO in its bloody heyday, Egypt now has the same problem that Israel faced starting in 1968 when the first and last El Al plane was hijacked successfully, to Algiers, symbolically enough, the most reviled of Barbary Pirate powers. Other attempts were made to hijack Israeli planes but were foiled. El Al planes were attacked when parked at a terminal or on the tarmac, but once airborne, one was safe, thanks to the extraordinary lengths that Israel has had to undertake to secure Israeli aviation. Now Egypt has to get its act in gear or get out of the airline business.

And people in what's left of the decadent liberal democracies also have to smash the idol of political correctness and declare Islam unique as a menace to mankind.

In college and graduate school, I majored in Comparative Religion and found wisdom and beauty in many of them. Hindu literature is epic, the Vedas, the Bhagwat Gita. Buddha and Confucius, the Taoists and the Jains, Native Americans, all had something to say, all expressed religious feelings, but none of them was like Islam. Islam is the only religion in the world preaching violent world conquest with its clergy routinely shrieking in their pulpits every Friday about jihad.

The Western democracies have to reverse at warp speed the policies of Obama who cannot say "Muslim terrorists."

By contrast, the enemy must be named and defined as accurately as possible before he can be defeated.

Yes, the enemy must be named and described honestly. That applies to Islamic terrorists in general and local Arab, allegedly moderate Fatah terrorists in particular.

Today's late news said John Kerry would indeed participate in the kangaroo court in Paris that French antisemites are convening. It was supposed to be in May but because of Memorial Day in the States it has been moved to June 3 when thirty countries will collectively agree that the Jews had better hand over Judea and Samaria or else. This is what these goy countries are cooking up now.

That will about the same number of countries that voted for that David Irving-like UNESCO abomination of a resolution denying if not the Holocaust than Jewish history in Jerusalem.

What are these people, nuts? And the answer is “Yes.” Their minds are polluted by antiJewitis, an infection really of the soul that produces homicidal hatred for the Jews who refuse to die.

Every religion practiced today is younger than Jewishness. Every nation alive today is younger than the Jewish people. The Jews were born in the age of the Pharaohs and the pyramids centuries before the Greeks entered history and their deeds recorded by Homer. The Jewish nation was born a thousand years for the age of Alexander the Great and even centuries more before the rise of the Caesars of Rome.

The Jews were around before King Arthur and his Knights of the Round Table came together in the mists of early English history. Long before the Teutonic knights in Germany and the Russian czars; before the kings of France who entered history at a certain point and left history for good in the 19th century.

And what this truth about the Jews, as the only immortal people, does to some goyim is annoy them, for it is evidence that there may be some truth to the Jews’ claim that G-d exists and wants His creation, man, to choose good over evil, and that is why He keeps the Jews alive as evidence of His desire ...as He subjects us to periodic massacres.

No people has a history like the Jews. King Louis the XIV of France, arguably the greatest of the French kings, was reported to have asked famous French philosopher Blaise Pascal for proof of the existence of G-d, and Pascal replied, “Why, the Jews, your majesty, the Jews.” Their existence is proof of His existence.

And the one time I visited the palace at Versailles, the guide said, as we stood outside the long throne room we could not enter, only just look into, that there the above the throne, he said, one could see, suspended by a wire from the ceiling, a kind of laurel wreath made of gold, modeled on the headgear of the High Priest in Jerusalem and was inscribed just like it in Hebrew with the four-letter name of Hashem. The king of France sat beneath the *tzitzit*, its Hebrew name, as a symbol of his divine right to rule. The G-d of the Bible empowered him to rule.

And that is why the goyim, leastwise many of their national leaders, will convene in Paris on June 3rd and be joined by the grandson of an apostate Jewish priest, John Kerry, to discuss what to do about those damned Jews who are obstacles to peace -- in their minds. All they have to do, the Jews, they think, is hand over the property that they stole from the Ancient Ones in 1967. Do that, and peace will reign between Israel and its victims, the Ancient Palestinians.

What is so weird about this behavior is that simultaneous to this news of French preparations for this multinational conference was an obscure news item about Fatah’s Facebook page two days ago. PMW translated and posted it for us. It was a photograph of the infamous terror attack by three Japanese assassins working for the diabolical Dr. George Habash back in 1974 who machine-gunned and grenade people in the airport baggage claim area at Lod. The anniversary is coming up and the Facebook post was to

celebrate and honor that battle in the “armed struggle” as they call it. Twenty-six dead bodies littered the floor in pools of their own blood, 80 others were also wounded and shredded by the explosions of the grenades and flying bullets.

One of three Japanese survived, Kozo Okamoto, and spent 13 years in an Israeli prison until Rabin let him go in 1985 in the infamous Jibril release of over a thousand. Okamoto then went to live in Lebanon with Habash’s PFLP that had sent him. Japan said he would be arrested if he returned to Japan. And I imagine he is still be alive because Fatah, those moderates, sent him “a thousand greetings” two days ago for what he did. May 30th is the 44th anniversary of that horror.

Among the dead, there were about a dozen Christian pilgrims from Puerto Rico and a world class Israeli scientist.

With such as today’s Fatah, John Kerry and in France Hollande and the heads of the 30 nations think there is the possibility of a peace deal with Fatah that is responsible for horrors like that. They think Israel should be forthcoming and hand over the heart of the Holy Land to Fatah, to Abbas, to the PA that yesterday printed its demonic praise for this mad dog killer, an assassin, a butcher.

What is going on in the world when Kerry and otherwise sober world leaders think this way? Think that Israel has to hand over the high ground to people who, once liberated from Israeli control, will surely be overrun and taken over by Iran and/or ISIS. Both the Shiites and the Sunnis are communities of barbarians obsessed with the Jews as evildoers and if Israel abandoned Judea and Samaria that is who would take over. All the polls show that Hamas is more popular there.

The contributions to civilization by Israelis, by its doctors, scientists and engineers are marvelously beneficial, yet in the minds of Ayatollah Khameini and millions of Muslims we are Nazis who murder Palestinians all the time. We have nothing better to do. We are evildoers who must be destroyed, G-d forbid.

I tell you, the world has been knocked off its axis. The Jewish idea, the very idea of Jews, has the power to create life and goodness and also the power no less to bring on hatred and homicidal violence.

The very idea of Jews makes the French think they know better than we do how to manage our lives here with these so-called Palestinians. And like the Muslims who claim the right to force Islam as the one and only correct religion on the world, the French think they have the right to force on Israel what they say is the proper thing to do; which is what they do; which is kowtow to the Muslims.

Now for some good news out of the States. The United Methodist Church meeting in Portland, Oregon, in its quadrennial gathering defeated four separate BDS-type

resolutions calling for the UMC to divest from Caterpillar, HP and Motorola because they do business in the racist, Fascist, apartheid state of Israel. But of course as Methodists they are too subdued to use such language but that was the subtext, I am sure. Every mainline church in the States has a pro-Balstinian caucus.

In January, the Pension Fund of the UMC decided to divest from Israeli banks claiming that Israel is a high risk country.

The Presbyterians are definitely in the hands of antiJews these days, the United Church of Christ also. But at least here the Methodists have held the fort so to speak. Some attribute it to Hillary Clinton's recent straightforward opposition to BDS against Israel. She grew up in the Methodist church.

The bad news out of the States, though, was on display in Isi Leibler's JPost column today when he rightly excoriated the new head the ADL, who took Abe Foxman's place, Jonathan Greenblatt. And I say Greenblatt's performance is a major indicator of the degenerate state of American Jewry -- the small Orthodox community excluded. This character Greenblatt is a "moral equivalence" type between Israel and our violent, vicious antisemitic goy neighbors here. Both sides are responsible, he has said. He also recognizes the "legitimacy of the Palestine Narrative." He has appeared before and thereby respected the J Street cultists, many of them the spawn of mixed marriages who do not like the connection to our hated people.

I think I saw this coming actually a quarter-century ago when I saw the handwriting on the wall. It was already clear in 1988, five years after the Reform said it was okay to marry non-Jews, the intermarriage rate had skyrocketed to about half, which demographically was evidence then this community is terminal. It is going out of business. It cannot survive with an intermarriage rate like that and that was clear back in 1988. And it is much worse now.

So I checked out Orthodoxy at the time, reviled by the Reform, because it was not going out of business. Over the next forty years, I reckoned back then, the only Jews in America would be the Orthodox and that is where we are heading. And here is the ADL now being led by this man alienated from the Jewish people. For sure, he is legally a Jew but I doubt he is Jewish in his views and probably behaviors. He is certainly not Jewish in his thinking that there is moral equivalence between us here in Israel and these brutal, barbaric goy neighbors of ours. The police today at Damascus Gate arrested another Arab youth on suspicion and discovered he was carrying a knife.

We haven't seen this kind of savagery -- stabbing Jews in the back in the street, slashing their throats -- since the days of Nazi Germany, and here is Mr. Greenblatt seeing responsibility on both sides for the strife.

Sorry. In England, during the Blitz, and in the US after Pearl Harbor, nobody saw moral equivalence with the Krauts and the Japs. This fence-sitting by Greenblatt of the
