From the Mind of Sha'i ben-Tekoa

Transcript

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Shalom laYehudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim. It is the evening of the 2nd day, *dales beMenachem Av, Parashas Devarim, tav-shin-ayin-vav*, the evening of the 1st day, Sunday, 7 August, 2016, webcasting from the hills of Judea from which one can see in the distance the coast of Gaza of the Philistines and NGOs galore there who help the Muslims aggress against Jews, not give us a moment's peace.

Alma Dishikra, a world of lies. So one of the top stories here that broke on Friday was the indictment on Thursday last week of a major Christian charity's director in Gaza who turned out to be a secret Hamas agent, that's the Muslim brotherhood, one of Barak Obama's favorite organizations.

It turns out that Mr. Muhammad El Halabi, which means "Muhammad from Aleppo," no Ancient Palestinian he, found work in the World Vision organization in Gaza 2005 and worked his way up to being director in 2010, and since then has funneled around \$50 million of the charity's money to the Jew-killers of Hamas. He has, in effect, funded such Hamas activities as firing rockets and mortars into Sderot, terrorizing the people and especially the children.

World Vision boasts of its mission of helping over 4 million children worldwide and claims that it sponsors 40,000 in Gaza alone, only now we know not only money donated to World Vision never reached its intended destination: food stuffs, medicines and cash and necessities wound up in Hamas hands too, in what the MSM called its "military wing," which is another huge lie in our world of lies. They have no military wing. They have no soldiers. These are murderers, antisemitic murderers who are

proud of that. It is their life's work. Hamas, Hezbollah, and other Muslim groups go to work every day with the goal of murdering Jews.

This guy Muhammad al-Halabi was arrested two months ago crossing into Gaza at the Erez Crossing and seems to have, in the interrogation period, spilled all the beans.

The chief executive of World Vision based in Australia, one Tim Costello, denied all knowledge of the embezzlement. He said he is "profoundly shocked by these allegations."

In the JPost report, the GSS said the organization was not aware of what he was doing, but I have my doubts. In Israel Hayom in an op-ed, Ariel Bolstein said World Vision here has a history of anti-Jewism, my word of course. He said the organization has a record of smearing Israel as the party behind the suffering Palestinian children in Gaza. He said that World Vision was perfectly aware that Hamas placed Gaza children in positions to be killed when Israel responds to attacks by Hamas. They were used as human shields.

Moloch. We know of Moloch in the Torah, to whom children were sacrificed. They claim, these Palestinians, to be the offspring of the Canaanites and in this regard they seem to be spiritually, if not biologically. Hamas is like the Muslims in Iran during the war with Iraq in the 1980s who sent children into minefields to get blown up and enable fighters behind them to have a clear path.

In 2012, World Vision accused Israel of not allowing Christian children to celebrate Easter in Jerusalem, which was a complete lie. And that is antisemitism by my definition: lying about Jews.

And what's also characteristic of antiJew lying is the imputation that not only are Jews doing evil to people, we enjoy it, we cackle over our cruelty and sadism.

World Vision also funded a media stunt some years back that you may remember called "Jesus at the Checkpoint," some street theater, I think, showing Jesus being harassed at a checkpoint that Arabs sometimes must pass through.

And as I have so often pointed out, antiJew hatred is commonly psychologically projective by accusing Jews of one's own crimes without being aware of that. For example, this Halabi character, as director of World Vision in Gaza, had himself interviewed and the interview was posted on the group's website, and in it he said that what he found most rewarding in his work was when "we manage to restore the smiles of children who are severely traumatized by the devastating bombs which killed part of their families." And guess whose bombs he was thinking of.

Others said about him that indeed he dedicated his life to helping children after seeing "the devastating impact of the conflicts in Gaza."

Notice, I am citing the New York Times coverage here, authored by the leftist Isabel Kershner and Diaa Hadid, a presumably self-described if mispronounced

Balestinian – and the use of the word “devastating” here two times in close proximity. The reference is of course to what Israeli ordnance has done to Gaza; it is “devastating.”

And I say that this is sick. It is the sickness of psychological projection. Here is this Arab funneling perhaps \$50 million to Hamas that used the money to fire thousands of unguided missiles and projectiles, into Israel terrifying people, killing some, doing damage to buildings and terrifying Jewish children, which triggered Israel’s self-defense to suppress the fire out of Gaza. And all this Arab savage sees -- all the Arabs only see --are the Israeli missiles that come back in return. They make no connection in their minds between their own actions and Israel’s oh so human self-defense. World Vision is there to make the children in Gaza smile after suffering at Israel’s hands, oblivious to what triggers Israel’s self-defense.

That’s another axiom yours truly has developed over a lifetime of pondering the minds of Arab antiJews. Jewish self-defense is always experienced as an unprovoked aggression.

World Vision’s top dog Tim Costello said, “Much of the organization’s work in Gaza was providing ‘safe places’ to deal with the trauma of repeated war, as well as agricultural projects.”

This outfit claims to collect and disperse over a billion dollars every year. They have offices in the US, Australia and the UK. It also receives contributions from the Australian and British governments so that the taxpayers in these two nations are sending money to Jew-killers.

No, the GSS may be right that the top echelon in World Vision was not aware of the embezzlement by this secret Hamas agent. Still, World Vision’s original sin must be judged -- apart from this particular situation -- for its record of antiJew support. The original sin, shared with 100s of other NGOs in Gaza, is the choice of sides in this violence here. They are so concerned for the children in Gaza traumatized by IDF self-defense but, apparently, are oblivious to the suffering of the children in Sderot who were reported to be in their overwhelming majority suffering from PTSD. Since 2001, the Arabs in Gaza have fired, I have it on good authority, some 30,000 projectiles into Israel at random. The number of dead and physically wounded is not high but the number of psychologically wounded could number in the hundreds of thousands of Jews.

In this, the NGOs in Gaza and especially the Christian ones like World Vision should be ashamed of themselves. The history of Christians aggressing against Jews is an indelible part of Christian behavior leading right up to and into the Holocaust. No, Christian theology was not used to justify the Final Solution, but it certainly prepared the groundwork over thousands of years of persecution, expulsions and massacres.

No, the Holocaust was not fueled directly by Christian thought, but the results of the Holocaust resembled the results of earlier spasms of Christendom gone crazy: the expulsions, the Inquisitions, the torture.

These NGOs, I have said before, are this generation's legitimate way of aggressing against Jews. In the past, it was the deicide charge that justified the aggression. Then it was the shared Nazi-Communist belief in the international Jewish conspiracy to take everyone's money and reduce the world to poverty-stricken slaves to them.

Today it is the crucifixion of the Balestinians by the Jews and their "devastating" cruelty in particular to the children of Gaza.

These Christians in World Vision and other Christian organizations like them are as twisted up in their heads as the Muslims in their heads when they weep over suffering at the hands of the demon Jews.

Well, another front-page story in Israel was the insult to the Israeli athletes in Rio de Janeiro last night. It seems that one bus was tasked with transporting the Lebanese athletes and the Israeli team, I guess from the dormitories to the stadium, for the opening ceremonies, only the Lebanese inside the bus, picked up first, would not let the Israeli athletes board.

An argument broke out, and in the end the Lebanese prevailed. Another bus had to be provided and the Israeli sailing coach posted on his Facebook page the word, "Shame. Shame on the Olympics for allowing this to happen."

In Israel, Ministress of Culture and Sport Miri Regev spat out charges of "racism" and "antisemitism," but that makes no sense in secular Zionist thinking. We are at war, under attack by a neighboring people, that's pretty normal, the Arabs, and since the Zionists' goal was creating a normal state, what is wrong with the Lebanese not wanting to ride in the same bus with the enemy? What has racism got to do with it? It is nationalism. What has antisemitism got to do with that?

Israelis like these angry over the incident want to have their cake and eat it too. They want to have a normal society, but when the neighbors next door go to war against us, there is nothing more normal than the desire not to associate with the enemy.

Israel's sailing coach said he was "shocked that this happened because it violates the spirit of the Olympic Games," which originated as a period of truce between warring peoples when their warriors would compete in non-lethal, athlete competition.

But surely no Israeli athlete, certainly not a coach, has the right to be shocked by this violation of the spirit of the Games. In 1972, the Fatah murder cultists based in Lebanon plotted their massacre of Israel's athletes, giving evidence that they had no respect

for the spirit of the Olympic Games back then. The Games are supposed to be a time of truce and peaceful, athletic games, not fighting and killing by warriors, but the Arabs have no more respect for this civilized tradition that then do for the inviolability of embassies and the immunity from attack for diplomats; and the restraint of not deliberately targeting non-combatants. The Arabs, the Muslims, have no respect for these distinctions.

In delving into the legendary, misnamed Barbary Pirates, I discovered that a declaration of war on the Barbary Shore against a Christian country was accompanied by the dispatch of a mob to swarm over its consulate, to chop down its flagpole and invade the building to loot and vandalize. It was not enough verbally to declare war. This is how it was done.

Also in our time, the PLO groups murder diplomats and attack embassies as at the Olympic Games in 1972. They thought nothing of not only murdering Jewish athletes but as we learned recently, castrating one of them in front of his teammates.

So what bothers me about the Israeli response to this incident in Rio with the bus is the outrage and the shock. Why? Instead of wailing about “racism,” Israel’s athletes should spin the incident into support for Israel by pointing out that our enemies are barbarians and so Israel is not shocked by their behavior. It is normal for these Arabs who have made themselves a curse on mankind with their atrocities.

I suppose it is just another example of how deJudaized Israelis can be. They should not be shocked or even dismayed.

This seems to be another moment in which the downside of growing up in Israel without religion produces Israelis shocked by such behavior and really misread it. The Lebanese behavior was not racist because the Jews are not a race. More accurate was the term “antisemitism” used by Miri Regev, even though that concept was a lie the moment it was invented 150 years ago. Antisemitism was meant to cover up and spin a hatred as old as Mt. Sinai, hatred of the Jews who by their immortality and achievements generate anger, envy and even guilt. The immortality of Jews and our functionally supernatural return home after 18 centuries of wandering, and the success of this tiny state, enrages antiJews today as they have been enraged in generation after generation.

The existence of Israel rattles some men’s minds and shakes up their souls. Israel’s existence and rule in Jerusalem rattles Islam to its foundations, not to mention the flotsam and jetsam of people still dreaming of Marxism and other socialist fantasies proven woefully wrong in the unfolding of history.

In 1961, the famous British historian/philosopher Arnold J. Toynbee in a debate with Israel’s ambassador to Canada Yaakov Herzog, famously dismissed the Jews as a fossil people. Initially, at the time of the Balfour Declaration, he had supported Zionism but then switched sides, turned anti-Zionist and supported the Arabs.

So I am bothered by this angry reaction of Israelis to this incident in Rio because it stems from a continuing secular Zionist ambition to put an end to antisemitism and turn

this people of Israel into just another normal nation. The bitter resentment, the shock here is rooted, I think, in being told, “You are not normal.”

Post-Jewish Israelis are forever yearning to be loved and accepted and not treated differently.

But this is obviously not the scenario or script written by the great Scriptwriter in the sky.

Here was an interesting coincidence last week: I was watching some pro-Israel video on line in which one of the clips was of an angry talking head. He looked to be someone interviewed on a political talk show, who shouted at the camera that, “ Hamas is not al-Qaida!”

And then in Friday’s JPost column by Liat Collins, she reported on being interviewed during the rocket war of 2014 by a London-based radio station during which the interviewer asked her, “Why don’t Israel and Hamas just sit down and talk instead of killing each other?”

She responded, “Why don’t the US and al-Qaida talk?” which triggered the “smug” response, her word, “Are you comparing Hamas with al-Qaida?” as if that was absurd.

The fever swamps of the antiJew mind never stop percolating and throwing up new accusations. First of all, notice the moral equivalence gambit here in the initial question: “Why don’t Israel and Hamas talk instead of kill each other?” as if both sides were equally guilty of for the killing and refusing to talk out and settle their differences.

And then the smug, condescending view that Hamas and al-Qaida are different, I guess as different as Fatah and Hamas are presumed to be. That presumptive difference was the basis of the Oslo abomination and stupidity. I know for a fact that in Rabin’s head Fatah was secular and patriotic and you could deal with them but not with those religious fanatics in Hamas, the Islamists. Oslo was based on the fallacy that one group was the good Jew-killers and the other group the bad Jew-killers. The latter were impossible to deal with, but not the former. They were secular, moderate, just like us Zionists. These were Fatah nationalists who just like us want a little piece of Palestine for a homeland.

Now it is in fashion to deny any similarity between those admittedly terrible al-Qaida terrorists who brought the World Trade Center and those Balestinians in Gaza, where Hamas dominates. I remember at the time in webcasts two years ago, during the 50 days of rockets, complaining of how the MSM continuously referred to the rocket-launcher boys and the tunnel rats as “Balestinians,” even though their organizations, like Hamas, like Islamic Jihad, were clearly Islamic, not Palestinian in orientation in the slightest.

There is here, I think, an unwitting collaboration for two different reasons between world antiJewry and Israel’s secular leaders, both of them not wanting to speak the truth

about the enemy for different reasons. As Barack Obama's most important and rock solid policy is never to link terror with Islam, so Israel must never be seen as the victim of Muslims, only those nice, moderate, secular Balestinians who just want their own cute, little state.

Hamas, according to its Covenant of 1988, available on line, and as it appears in my book, does not waste any time in declaring itself a branch of the Muslim Brotherhood, and it irritates yours truly no end that Israel continues to call Hamas Hamas instead of the Muslim Brotherhood, the same cult that Obama brought to power in Egypt after knocking over Mubarak, an American ally who had kept the peace with Israel for decades.

Al-Qaida no less is the product of the same culture: these are belligerent, aggressive Muslims. The idea that Hamas is no al-Qaida is simply ridiculous. They are both famous for their suicide bombers in planes or in our buses. It reflects either the ignorance or the malevolence of anyone who says they are different. Both Israel's secular leadership and the lunatics on the other side wave the banner of the Balestinians because they want to distract people from seeing the religious roots of the hostility to Israel by these Muslims.

In my book, I show how even the name Fatah, the allegedly secular group, was a name chosen for its Islamic meaning of "conquest of the infidel."

So that's the new trope: Hamas is not al-Qaida, like Fatah is not Hamas. Same old story. Everybody knows al-Qaida are the bad guys who must not be identified with Hamas, the victims of Zionism.

I've said it for years now: Israel has made a huge mistake ever since in 9-11 by not re-branding the Arabs as Muslims and not Balestinians who are just like the Zionists used to be, pining for their own state for thousands of years.
