Shalom laYehudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim. It is the evening of the 4th day, *yud-alef beElul, Parashas Ki Saytsay, tav-shin-ayin-vav*, the evening of the 3rd day, Tuesday, 13 September 2016, webcasting from the last real estate on earth where it is permitted, and is even virtuous, to proclaim, "No Jews Allowed."

That was the big news over the weekend, Bibi's two-minute video on Friday, and "Finally," I say, bravo on two counts. Netanyahu finally raised the issue, if still only by implication, of Jewish rights to live in Judea and Samaria, something you all long-term, friendly subscribers have heard me kvetch about for years repeatedly. Of course, the world bashes us for stealing the "West Bank" from the Balestinians because we never claim it. Israel never refutes that claim by claiming this land as ours as of right. We have the right not only to live in Judea and Samaria but annex it and include it in our tiny country. But we never do that.

One of the benefits of the perdurability of Jew-hatred in every generation is the validation that the antiJew gives to the power of Jewishness and the immortality, thus far, of the Jewish nation, the only one that does not die.

When I think about the size of Russia stretching over 11 time zones, almost half the circumference of the globe; or think about American history and how that country expanded four time zones from sea to shining sea, and then observe the behavior of the nations of the world, in classical Hebrew the *goyim*, the nations of the world and what we as kids called the "conniption fits" the world has over the "injustice" of Israel actually keeping the 2,000 square miles it won on the battlefield in 1967 *i.e.* Judea and Samaria.

Imagine mapping out a square in Texas or Alaska 40 miles by 50 miles – that is the size of Juda and Samaria and the world goes crazy over our presence in it.

The idea of Israel actually keeping the high ground that the savage Arabs had launched their murder raids from for two decades, “Well,” says the world, “no, no, we can’t have that. Let the Jews keep the spoils of war? No, the Jews must return to the Arab nation that high wall mountains called by the whole world the “West Bank” and backs our Arab enemies because the Arabs never had a name for this terrain. They never called it anything. They have no records of the history of this putatively Paleolithic Palestinian people, and what they were up to in history. No one knows what kind of governments they had. Did they have a king? A prince? A chancellor to lead them? Or, maybe they had a national council of elders to guide them? What wars did they fight against their nation’s enemies?

The “Palestinians” is the verbal, notional equivalent of a smokescreen. The Arabs in general are famous for their veils and their burkas, keffiyas and jellabiya robes that cover everything. And then there is their compulsive molesting of Western women who walk down their streets in a Western dress. They have this thing about exposure and hiding.

The Arabs, descendants of Ham son of Noah who exposed his father’s nakedness, and they are acutely sensitive to issues of shame, if not guilt. They are noted for the practice of *taqqiya*, dissembling, presenting a false front even among themselves. And so with the help of non-Arab world antiJewry, antiJew Jews and anti-Jew Gentiles alike, they have all concocted this verbal smoke screen to cover up their Arab hunger for the wealth of others, on the one hand, and their Muslim intolerance of people who don’t believe Muhammad was a great guy, on the other.

In other words, long before the “Palestinians” strode upon the stage of history, their forefathers were “Syrian Arabs” and “Muslims” who hated the Jews and tried to destroy their state and of course loot it for the spoils of war. And that had nothing to do with “Palestinians.” As Arabs and as Muslims our neighbors have always felt the same way about us long before the invention of this “Palestinian” identity, which is really more *taqqiya*, more dissembling, presenting a false front.

You know how the Muslim enemy agent in the Oval Office told the American people dozens of times in full view of the world one lie after another about Obamacare. That too was *taqqiya*. He was dissembling in front of the whole planet.

So. Bibi on Friday finally said something, if only directly, affirming the right of Jews to live in Judea and Samaria. Two weeks ago, if you remember, I spoke of the photographs in the New York Times taken of Mitzpeh Danny/the Danny Outpost with its forty families in the middle of nowhere. Well, this is just another episode in the same soap opera that never stops running. Bibi said what he said, and the State Department and the Arabs and really the entire world that does not recognize

Jerusalem as our capital or a right to live in Judea and Samaria, collectively cried out, “Hey! There goes the neighborhood. The Jews are moving in and we can’t allow that. Who do these pushy Jews think they are? They think they have the right to live wherever they want.” That is what this is all about.

I find it hysterical in both senses of that word, its clinical and colloquial meanings. Clinical, in the sense of being crazy, and hysterical in the sense of funny. Here in these pictures we saw these forty Jewish families bothering nobody, but their presence, and the presence of similar Jewish communities bothering nobody, enrages the international community of enlightened, progressive, anti-racist, anti-imperialists. They say these Jews in these caravans are the obstacle to peace – and never mind the Arabs hated Israel no less before the existence of this particular cluster of prefabs in the middle of nowhere.

Israel’s victory in 1967 was a millennial milestone in the history of Homo sapiens, what both Jewish Scripture and Paleontologists agree became recognizably human beings about 6,000 years ago. Then, the Jews for 18 centuries had been known as a rootless, hostile foreign community inside other societies where they lived on sufferance. Gentile children were educated to believe that the Jews were being punished by expulsion from their Promised Land because they killed Jesus, their Messiah and really God Himself. The Jews are so evil and powerful, they had the power to kill G-d Himself.

And as they had been wandering for centuries on end, they would continue to wander until the Second Coming of Jesus.

Yet here in 1967, the Jews returned with no Second Coming. And as for the Muslims, the return of the Jews to Jerusalem meant the loss of the Temple Mount which for fourteen centuries had been a sign of the truth of Islam as the final and greatest revelation, and whose prophet was the greatest prophet of all.

The return of the Jews to Hebron as well, home of the family plot of the Jewish people, and to Shechem, burial town of Joseph the Righteous, Prime Minister of Egypt, and to Bethlehem, the location of his mother Mother Rachel’s tomb and the world was rattled.

I remember visiting Bethlehem on Christmas Eve 1975 to watch Midnight Mass, from the outside, with some friends, to watch the processional of priests through Manger Square, and I observed above us on the rooftops around the square, armed IDF soldiers in combat gear protecting the proceedings from PLO terrorists, protecting these Christian divines. And at one point, I set eyes on one of the priests also looking up at the soldiers as he walked toward the Church of the Nativity, and I didn’t think he was a happy man. The expression on his face seemed to say that he did not like being guarded by Jewish soldiers in a resurrected Jewish Holy Land. It wasn’t supposed to be like this.

Ten years earlier, the Catholic Church published *Nostra Aetate*, the Papal Bull meaning “In Our Time,” which was a major course correction in Catholic doctrine. It took the Church twenty years after the Holocaust to reach this point when so many of the major devils, starting with Hitler himself, had been baptized in their faith, but they finally got around to declaring that no longer would the Church call all Jews alive today, and really throughout history, “Christ-killers.” No, the new doctrine held fast to the old doctrine that the Jews back then were responsible for killing Jesus way, but no longer would other Jews be seen as born bearing their guilt.

But, not surprisingly, a significant slice of the Roman Catholic community did not like the new doctrine. At this time as well, the Vatican licensed conducting the mass in a local language so parishioners could finally understand what was being said. No longer was it to be conducted in Latin.

And no less, the opposition to this did not like the new dispensation towards the Jews. There were breakaway congregations still doing the mass in Latin, and men like Mel Gibson’s father and Mel Gibson himself, who surely loved his father, and columnist Pat Buchanan, Old School Roman Catholics who did not like Vatican II. Like pulling a security blanket from a baby who then begins to squall, no small number of Roman Catholics refused to relinquish the old narrative.

And really the whole world rebelled against Israel after 1967 because Israel’s jaw-dropping military prowess -- when for centuries Jews did not fight back -- was amazing. They did not fight back, for this would license their tormentors to murder them and get away with it, leaving a wife and children without them. So they did not. So Jews got to be wimps, doctors, lawyer, accountants perhaps, but not physical types.

Yet the Israelis in 6 days did a number on the armed forces of four Arab states, survived, and grew four times in size.

And above all, the Jews had returned to Judea and Jerusalem.

So, Bibi did something last Friday that I had been hoping he would do for donkeys’ years. The Internet may be the herald of the coming of Moshiach because it affords people pretty much anywhere on earth to talk to everybody on earth, billions of people and all at the same time.

For years, you’ve heard me imagine the prime minister responding to some crisis by calling a press conference for the entire press corps in Israel, the hundreds of them, to speak to the whole world a message like this, but now I see how old-fashioned I was in my thinking. Who needs an auditorium with journalists to record your words and report on them to the world? In a way, the Internet destroys a major function of journalism. Who

needs journalists to report to their newspaper's readers what a politician said, when via the Internet you can watch him say it. You no longer need the journalists' transmission services.

I hope Bibi makes a habit of doing these little videos like this and, as in this case, exposing the irrational and unjust attitudes that people harbor and nurture about Israel being in Judea and Samaria, where, you know, those "extremist religious settlers" are the obstacle to peace. It is they and their settlements that are to blame for the absence not only of peace but the creation of the Ancient State of Palestine that the Ancient Palestinians have been pining for since the dawn of man.

Bibi, I hope, makes a habit of this. These two-minute videos – people's attention these days -- in which calmly, as he did on Friday, he exposes the dishonesty of the antiJews holding Jews to standards no other people are shackled with. In the minds of the world, leastwise their representatives in the closest thing there is to a world government, the UN, Israel must hand back the land it captured in self-defense. Israel has no right to Judea and Samaria and certainly no right to allow its Jews to make their homes there. This land belongs to the "Palestinians," and never mind that before Israel's victory in 1967, the UN never heard of this nationality with a claim on this real estate.

For two decades, the kings of Jordan didn't think the Arabs in the hills of Judea and Samaria, as these areas were marked for thousands of years, were a people belonging to a foreign nation. Those two kings, direct descendants of Prophet Muhammad, did not think there was a nation there deserving of its own independent state, but ever since Israel's greatest victory, it has been a "crime" denying the "Palestinians" the heartland of "their" historic homeland of Palestine – and never mind the League of Nations in black and white called all this real estate the historic homeland of the Jewish (!) people.

"No," say today's antiJews, gentile and Jewish alike, "the League of Nations committed a terrible injustice by not even mentioning the Palestinians in their deliberations. This was so typical of those racist Europeans with their far-flung colonies. Palestine would become another one, only administered by the Jews, when the world says today, this is the historic homeland of the "Palestinians."

That seems to be some kind of gas in the atmosphere, some kind of chemical warfare, in which whole populations are sprayed with a substance that has them hallucinating a "Palestinian" people who are the victims of the Jews -- as the evil Jews have victimized people in every generation.

Not that everyone has been intoxicated with these delusions about Ancient Palestinians and their cruel Jewish tormentors, but many people have.

Bibi in his little video twice used the word "outrageous" to describe the demand that all Jews in Judea and Samaria must be expelled and the tolerance of the idea no less outrageous.

The State Department spokesperson icily rejected the term “ethnic cleansing” that Bibi rightly used to describe the widespread acceptance of the Arab demand that all Jews must be expelled.

The State Department spokeswoman refused to lay out the reason why “ethnic cleansing” does not apply in this. This has been, by the way, the official position of the PLO playing *taqqiya* as the Palestinian “Authority” since its creation. I remember watching Hanan Ashrawi on TV on September 13, 1993, commenting on the Oslo Abomination taking place on the White House lawn that day, insisting that despite all the hoopla of peace breaking out, she said there would be no peace until all Israelis and their settlements are gone. That was 1993, and here we are 23 years later and nothing has change.

And it is to Israel’s great shame that in this period, its leaders have been these post-Jewish, religion-hating, secular Zionists of the Left, like Rabin, whose parents were hateful Communists, and Peres the adolescent fan of Karl Marx and Yossi Beilin, who publically sneered at religion, “I’m not a believer,” I once heard him say. It was revolting to see them all shaking hands with that bloodthirsty ghoul Arafat (ghoul is an Arabic word, by the way) and his sidekick Mahmoud Abbas. And no less sickening was all the years they violated all their promises, and these same leaders of Israel did nothing and said nothing.

Israel’s leaders were so drunk on the adulation showered on them by antiJew Gentiles and antiJew Jews, with their smiles and backslapping and congratulations, oblivious to the subterranean agenda of abandoning Judea, Samaria and Jerusalem to the monsters of the PLO, which is what Oslo was also about.

And here we saw today that right behind Bibi’s Friday video in which he used the term “ethnic cleansing” that so enraged the Enlightened, to describe the fantasy of expelling a half-million Jews, two days later the same Mahmoud Abbas from 1993 delivered his annual address on the occasion of today’s Aid al-Adha festival in which he accused Israel of “ethnically cleansing Balestinians.”

I tell you, these Arabs have no originality, and our sages were so wise when they said that “Ishmael is a thief,” for here was Abbas stealing Bibi’s accusation and throwing it back at him. At this festive meal, he accused Israel of “ethnic cleansing,” and never mind there are twice the number of Arabs today in Yesha than in 1967, and also Israel’s “premediated murder.” Here we have been for the last year witness to scores of Jews murdered with premeditation, malice aforethought by these boys with knives that he encourages. Here is this savage charging us with that accusation.

With such low life, intellectual low life, peace talks are waste of time and breath.

Yes, today is part of the four-day Muslim festival called *Id al-Adha*. *Id* is the Arabic mispronunciation of the Hebrew word *ait/ayin-taf* meaning, time or time period, like *moed*,

with *adba* meaning “sacrifice.” This is the Feast of the Sacrifice when Ibrahim, their mispronunciation of Avraham, bound his son Isma’il, another mispronunciation, for a sacrifice, and submitted to Allah’s command, only, at the last minute, Allah stopped him.

In this plagiarized version of the original story, not only did the professional thieves of Araby change the *dramatis personae*, they changed where the story takes place. At the Kaaba in Mecca, they said, not in Jerusalem on Mt. Moriah, the future sight of the Temple. And not only that, Muslims misunderstand the story woefully. Islam means “submission” and refers to Ibrahim submitting to the will of Allah. Ibrahim suppresses his own will and submits to what Allah wants.

And not surprisingly, when Muslims pray, they go down on their knees, face into the floor, the posture of a slave before his master. For Muslims, mindless obedience is the highest form of piety, when the test Avraham endures was not about that.

On one level, submission/obedience is a virtue. One has to do what one is told, sometimes without understanding. Imagine a frisky, curious, two-year old boy is about to see what might happen if he inserts a metal knife into an electrical socket. Mommy sees this about to happen and yells at him, knocks the knife out of his hand and he begins to cry. He has no understanding of electricity and this is no time to start teaching him the principles of Faraday. We learn to obey our parents without understanding and this is similar.

But what is at stake for Avraham is not blind obedience but the strength of his conviction that among all deities among all deities, HaShem is not a cruel god. Hashem is testing his faith in Him as a kind, not cruel god.

And there is evidence in the text for this interpretation. When Avraham and Isaac part from their servants after three days of walking toward the future Jerusalem, Avraham says to them, “Stay here with the donkey and I and the youth we’ll go there, prostrate ourselves, and we will return.”

“We will return”? Avraham sees the two of them returning? And when Isaac asks, “Here is the wood and here is the fire, but where is the lamb?” Avraham answers, “G-d will provide.” And whaddaya know, G-d does provide, if not a lamb than a ram.

In other words, Abraham’s love and belief in G-d as he envisions Him is that of a God who is not into human sacrifice like the Canaanites, like the Aztecs, like the Hindus at one time and too many peoples who were into human sacrifice in which it was common for a father to sacrifice his son. Avraham just knew that his G-d, HaShem, would not go through with it, and in the end, Avraham was right.

Versus the Muslims for whom, as Musab Hassan Yusef says, Son of Hamas, Islam’s problem is that Islam’s god is a cruel god.

And I add, Islam's god wants mindless slaves for devotees, versus the Jewish G-d of a people that He personally took them out slavery to a life of freedom and free will.

Well, I am sure that today some Israeli government functionary, even the president, sent holiday greetings to the Muslims on the occasion of *Id al-Adha*, oblivious to the intellectual property theft of this religion in general and this story in particular, this spiritual property theft that is characteristic of Islam and the depth of its religious hostility to the sons of Yitzhak by the sons of his half-brother Ishmael. Rashi teaches that after Ishmael was expelled from Avraham's tents, he became a highway robber. And that is true.

Maybe it is also HaShem's kindness that keeps Israelis in the dark about our neighbors and the impossibility of changing them. If Israelis truly plumbed the depths of Islam's hatred of the Jews, they might find out that the "Palestinians" have nothing to do with it.

Last item, in keeping with the last segment, last evening two girl soldiers drove up from the Jordan River Valley using WAZE to guide them and instead of Beit Lid in Israel that they asked for, they wound up inside Tulkarm and not surprisingly were greeted by street Arabs surrounding the car, pelting it with rocks and scaring the hell out of them.

Fortunately, a PA security guard was at hand, who called for backup and they rescued the girls from the mob.

With people like this, who bleat that they want peace with us, only a fool believes that. If they really wanted peace with us, wanted to be our good neighbors, they would demonstrate the behavior of good neighbors but they never do.
