Title: Did You See That Video?

Did you see it? Did you see that video of those two little Jewish children trembling in fear of the rockets fired at them? They were in their bomb shelter in Sderot. We are almost three-quarters of a century after Auschwitz and these kids were trembling like Jewish kids in Holland in hiding. Anna Frank lives.

Shalom laYehudim, Shalom laBnai Noach, Shalom laGoyim. It is the evening of the 6th day, *rosh khodesh Kislev, Parashas Toldos, taf-shin-peh*, 5780, the evening of the 5th day, Thursday, 28 November, 2019, webcasting from the homeland of Jewish people still the target of homicidal maniacs consumed with their hatred of Jews who they believe are the root of all evil.

And Israel is paralyzed. Utter incompetence. The alleged superpower of the Middle East, the “big bully” of their “victims” the Arab Muslims, are incapable of stopping these barbarians in Gaza from doing this. Incapable.

Most of my conscious life, Gaza has been a part of it. Let's see, in 1956, as a fifth grader in elementary school during Current Events time, when the exercise was bringing into class something from a newspaper, and it was my turn in the last days in October or first of November when Israel, England and France went to war against Egypt. In English, it was called the Sinai Campaign, which included overrunning the Gaza Strip. In Hebrew, we call it *Mivtza Kadesh*/Operation Kadesh, a notable location in Sinai we read about in the Five Books.

I had of course had little understanding as a ten-year-old of what Israel was, except that it was Jewish. I knew nothing of the Gaza Strip. We once lived about a mile from a single runway airstrip for light planes, and so I imagined this strip was like that; a long, concrete runaway on which the Arabs lived, pitching their tents on concrete.

Nine years later, by accident so to speak, I spent some months in Kibbutz Nir Am that abuts the Gaza Strip and sometimes on Shabbat, the Nahal army unit of boy and girl soldiers stationed there would walk over to the fence with its guard towers manned by UN peace-keeping soldiers, with me tagging along, to drink beer and socialize with them. The fence was easy to duck under. The soldiers were all Scandinavians, and I was amazed how blond they all were.

Some evenings the same boy and girl soldiers, with me tagging along, would leave the kibbutz and walk over to Sderot to sit in a café, drink some coffee and chat, when Sderot was still very much a construction site, a development town for mostly Moroccan refugees. The 650,000 Jewish refugees who ran to Israel in 1948 and another wave in 1956 as a result of the Sinai Campaign and the independence of Morocco and Tunisia were no better off on arrival than the 590,000 Arabs registered in 1949 as refugees from our War of Independence. These Jews also went into refugee camps, the *maabarot* of tents and Quonset huts and it took 25 years to get the last of these refugees out of the camps and into solid housing, with a job and schools and stores.

Rather, more accurately, what happened is that most of the Jews over time left but some stayed behind and all the time improved the little space they had and created livable, solid housing, so in the end they did not want to leave and the camp was rezoned as a residential community for those who never left and were content with the homes they had built.

About these refugees the world says nothing and they received nothing from the UN, unlike the 70% of the Muslims in Gaza who to this very day live on the UN dole and never suffer a manpower shortage when they feel most religious and believe it is good to fire rockets at Jews in their homes in Sderot.

Did you see this video that went viral of these trembling, terrified little Jewish children terrified by homicidal goyim trying to kill them?

And after watching the few seconds of this video, I felt that I would not object if every aircraft in the Israeli force capable of dropping bombs and firing guns at the ground were armed and launched to pass over Gaza single file, hundreds of them, blasting a strip down the middle of the Strip, say, a mile-wide. Think of Sherman's treatment of the rebel state of Georgia during the American Civil War; think of the burning of Atlanta.

I am raging at these Arabs in Gaza who are on a moral plane with Nazis. And I am furious with the State of Israel that does not know how to deal with this endless, demoniacal torture of Israeli Jews in Sderot and environs; Sderot originally created for

Jews fleeing Arab Muslim violence against them in faraway Morocco and really all across the Arab world just because they were Jews. The Arabs in these countries, not all of them, but some of them, felt they had the right in their countries to react to the defeat of their brethren in Palestine in 1948 to murder Jews at random, raping and looting. Not many Arabs, but enough to terrorize 650,000 Jewish people out of these countries in the knowledge they would be going into these miserable transit camps in Israel. My book cites some of the known pogroms across the Arab world in this period.

Yes, Gaza has been a part of my life almost all my life, this “Old Faithful” of a piece of real estate endlessly gushing Ishmael-clones who get paid to launch rockets at Jews in their homes in Sderot. Watching this video of those trembling Jewish children, I want to say to Gaza, “All of you can go to Hell,” and I say to Israel’s leaders across the board, “You haven’t got a germ of an idea how to put a stop this modern-day version of terrorizing Jews like those thrown into the Coliseum to be sliced up by gladiators or eaten by lions for the amusement of the goyim in Rome.”

Here we are the Startup Nation, the new Silicon Valley, world leader in computer science and military science and medicine who appear, leastwise to me, to be living in a dream world.

Naftali Bennett, tough guy, as the new defense minister, has boldly decided not to return the bodies of the homicidal Muslim Arabs we kill in self-defense, and certainly not so long as they refuse to return the remains of our boys to their families, these sadistic bastards.

But tough guy Naftali also supports the government’s ongoing negotiations with Hamas for a long-term relationship without violence. Bennett was reported today to support giving economic benefits to Gaza on two conditions; that the money they receive will not come from Israel and every rocket launch will be answered.

The good news yesterday was that for the third Friday in a row, tomorrow, there will be no violence at the Gaza barrier, and separately, the IDF will now allow Gaza’s fishermen to go out 15 nautical miles. This week as well another Qatari bagman showed up after conferring with Israeli officials, and handed out 100 dollars in Gaza to each family in need; I guess thousands of them.

In Barbary Pirate days, the local pasha would receive petitioners in his Court on certain days, all of them basically asking for a handout, and he would oblige by having a slave hand out coins.

Likewise, Saddam Hussein no less would sometimes receive petitioners and would hand out the cash from a stack of bills next to him. He was reported to have a billion dollars in notes in his palace.

The Israeli way of dealing with Gaza is that of a businessman. Money is the solution, improving the economic situation in Gaza will buy peace. In Barbary days, this was called the tribute. Either pay the pashas of the North African port cities or see one’s merchant ships captured and the people aboard enslaved.

And that is what the situation here is much about. Israel allows itself to be mugged and believes this is the way to deal with the Muslims in Gaza.

Only, history proves it is a false solution because it never buys true peace. It is a way of life for these Arab Muslims, so many of them perfectly at ease with murdering Jews as a good thing to do.

Thomas Jefferson learned this during his five years in Europe when he was constantly trying to, and failing to, liberate American hostages in Algiers. And this was a decade before he became President and later famous for launching the mission "...to the shore of Tripoli."

In his years in Paris, he read up on Islam, bought a translation of the Koran, discussed the situation with European diplomats and asked how their countries managed their relations with the Mussulmen on the Barbary Shore and concluded it was not possible to put an end to this behavior on the part of the Mussulmen without an intelligent military strategy which did not mean an aggressive war but a variety of siege warfare, a blockade of these ports from which Muslim cruisers set sail to capture, loot and enslave. Jefferson wanted America to build a navy, it had none in his years, because he wanted a naval blockade that might have to be sustained for forty years until a new generation of Mussulmen grew up who knew nothing of sailing. A blockade would force them as well to give up maritime piracy as a way of life and learn to become farmers, for Jefferson understood that while inland from the shore there was a great desert, the coast was fertile enough for farming. Jefferson the social theorist puzzled why it was that the climate and soil were not that different from southern Europe -- Mediterranean Spain, France and Italy -- but the Mussulmen did not practice agriculture like the Europeans but chose instead a life of sea-going brigandage.

Yes, the Israelis hit back every time the Muslims in Gaza fire off rockets at us. The alleged ceasefire of a week ago, I think -- Ceasefire No. 345.6 -- has not stopped the rocket fire completely. One a day, two a day. Iron Dome knocks down what it can, but nothing has stopped the sirens from wailing and scaring little Jewish boys and girls to death. With Israel the Startup Nation clueless. Yes, the IDF hits back and destroys more inert objects and sometimes a few dozen jihadis, but so what?

On the home front, the political paralysis continues. The good news is that in this political season, the anti-Bib-ites say nothing of the sacred Two-State Solution favored by World AntiJewry; even the Left has no spirit to call for that. Not when their standard bearer Benny Gantz has gone public with his 1967-style Alon Plan claim to the Jordan River Valley as permanently Israeli territory no matter.

But if so, one also needs sovereignty over the roads leading to the valley. Israelis like Gantz never play out what it means to keep the Valley, which logically must lead to claiming all of Judea and Samaria as legitimately, legally, and morally ours.

It was welcome news, the policy shift in Washington, about our right to live in Judea and Samaria, and one can only long for the day Israelis will recognize the identical right for Gaza. Our right to Judea and Samaria is rooted in the League of Nations Mandate and no less the territory of what today is called the Gaza Strip that no Israeli fights for. The government surely does not in its relationship to Gaza. It wants to pay the tribute; it wants to buy peace, when Jefferson's investigation taught him this was no solution to the aggression.

What Israel needs to do and should do so long as President Trump is in office is follow up this policy shift with one of our own, declaring that the people in Gaza have a choice: they can either end these horrific, satanic, nightmarish rocket attacks and live in peace, or in two years' time, we will cease supplying the Strip with everything that we do. We will stop sending in hundreds of semi-trailers every day, stop supplying electricity and water. Enough!

We should declare that nothing will change if the rockets do not stop; we will continue with the support that we provide for two years, and then its "lights out" in Gaza of the Philistines. Israel will no longer tolerate these rocket attacks and no longer abase ourselves by sustaining the Arab Muslims who fire these rockets at us.

Enough already. I think one piece of Israel's paralysis stems from its corruption. It is busy enjoying being the Startup Nation, going to the mall, buying new cars, vacations abroad. It is a scandal that Israel permits this torture of Jews. That is what every one of these rocket attacks is all about. Obviously, with Iron Dome and private and public shelters, very few Jews have been injured by the rockets directly, but surely after two decades, there have been hundreds of cases of people going into shock and being raced off to hospital, and a whole generation of children have had a childhood punctuated by the terror of the sirens. With every attack, we also hear of people racing for shelter, falling and hurting themselves.

In a very real way, the fire and flames of WWII for Jews never really went out. As in 1945, there are still millions of people who hate us and do not object to the torture of the rockets and would be happy to see us all killed, G-d forbid.

Recently George Galloway, another English Jew-hater, like Jeremy Corbyn, said he opposed antisemitism, meaning, abusing Jews in England, but, said Galloway, there is nothing wrong with hating Israelis.

In effect, the irrational hatred that has always fueled crazed Jew-haters like him has now been transferred to Israel and focuses on Israel. Hating Israel is the new Jew-hatred.

Maybe you saw this week's interview with the blatantly corrupted by his eternal hatred of Jews Jeremy Corbyn. Four times he refused to apologize for the no longer in doubt antisemitism in his Labour Party.

Just like Ilhan Omar and foreign ministries around the world on January 27, Corbyn insists he is opposed to antisemitism but as one of many such hatreds. The subtext is that the Jews are not the Chosen People, chosen for a special strain of hatred. They deserve no

special concern. And in any case, hating Israel has nothing to do with the antisemitism and its outlandish charges of conspiracies. Israel deserves to be hated for crucifying the neo-Philistines. Haters like Corbyn and their ilk are at war with the Jewish people, now in another war with the foreigners in Gaza, as the Philistines were also foreigners, whose very name tells us they were foreign invaders from the verb “to invade.” Corbyn & Co. want us to lose, big time. They want us to come down from the high ground we took away from the sons of Ishmael in 1967 and let the Neo-Philistines take over. This is called the Two-State Solution that 107 Democrats in Congress just called for in opposition to Pompeo’s announcement.

The Democratic Party has come a long way from being a staunch supporter of Israel. President Harry Truman recognized the state right away against the desire of his antiJew Secretary of State George Marshall. Bobby Kennedy became a warm supporter of Israel when in 1948 he worked here as a foreign correspondent during the War of Independence and was assassinated twenty years later for leading the Senate in support of selling Phantom Jets to Israel after the Six-Day War.

Lyndon Johnson no less was a supporter.

Well, generations come and generations go, and when AIPAC prefers Obama over Bibi, when the Democrats actually supported that Clinton woman, the Democrat Party has become sclerotic and unhinged. When their leaders in Congress are Pelosi, Schiff, Nadler, when their current slate of aspiring presidential candidates are a string of oddballs and losers, the Democratic Party has become as degenerate as the decadent culture it has nurtured over the last half-century.

In 1967, even the radical Left was pro-Israel in the run-up to the Six-Day War; there was no romance yet with the Third World and Islam.

To quote Bob Dylan from that time, “The times they are achangin’.”

Yes, here on the home front, when daily the news exposes more ugliness among our politicians, Benny Gantz committed a public act of identification with the Israeli Left that has beatified Yitzhak Rabin who brought down on this people the nightmare years of the Oslo Abomination, and simultaneously smeared Benjamin ben Bentzion with guilt for incitement, as if he subtly encouraged opponents of Oslo to assassinate Rabin.

This could not be more dishonest. Even if Bibi wanted that to happen in his heart of hearts, he was never so stupid as to incite in even the subtlest ways. It is an accusation as stupid and irrational as it is dishonest and ugly. Gantz said the current political situation “risks igniting an internal war between us. In the fact of Netanyahu’s calls of incitement and hate, I stand before you in the name of many people from right and left and tell you, it’s time to heal Israeli society.” What low-level rhetoric, political and social baloney.

Then he also said that “The man who led a harsh and painful incitement campaign against Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin – a campaign that ended in a terrible national

disaster—should well know the dangerous price of words that could, heaven forbid, turn into deadly bullets.”

This is revolting. It is very Saul Alinsky, Hillary’s guiding light, who taught her that against a political opponent, one can say anything to diminish him in the eyes of his supporters and the electorate. The allegations need not be true. The purpose is to smear him and sow doubt as to his integrity. “The charges *could* be true, you know.”

The Rabin family has this religious belief that Netanyahu in opposition to Yitzhak’s peace genius hinted to his supporters to kill Yitzhak, which accusation, I think, is their psychological defense against the truth that while Yigal Amir was guilty of killing this one man, Rabin was responsible for the deaths of more than a thousand Jews by his bone-headed adoption of the crank theories of Dr. Beilin and his mentor St. Simon of Oslo, who by their foolish and antisemitic support for the Muslim Fatah Jew-killers, because they did not know that Fatah was not, as they imagines, a secular, nationalist organization, but a chapter title in the Koran that encourages and praises dissembling a phony peace to deceive the enemy.

The hatred of Bibi as an inciter to Yitzhak’s assassination is, I think, a distraction away from facing the reality that it was Yitzhak Rabin who was responsible for all the horrors that followed bringing into the country tens of thousands of Fatah terrorists.

Gantz accused Netanyahu this week of egging “people on toward civil war, brother against brother” and I say this is enough for me. I never any impression of Gantz but now I see he identifies with least savory of Israelis. His campaign for a secular Israel puts him in the same camp as mayor of Tel-Aviv Ron Huldai who, by the way, now has to face a fleet of angry taxi drivers whose most lucrative days had been the Sabbath and now complain of what I pointed out at the beginning of this aggression against classical Jewishness of no public transport of the Sabbath. They do not complain about the violation of the Sabbath -- that is what they do; they complain that the service is free and thus is cutting into their accustomed level of income, big time.

I said when I first heard of this nasty plan that the fact of its being free, paid for by the taxpayers of Tel-Aviv, was an indication of its crusading purpose against Jewishness, encouraging Jews to violate the Sabbath.

Hanukah is coming up this month, which holiday commemorates a war that began not against the Syrian Greeks but as a civil war between Jews who wanted to live as Jews against those who wanted to live like Syrian Greeks. It began as a civil war, an internal war, in Gantz’s words.

The Democrats accuse Trump being a Russian agent, when they were the Russian agents, so Benny Gantz accuses Bibi of inciting to civil war, when that is his crime.
