

entirely inhabited by nomads. It should, however, be noted that the Turkish government has developed a town at Hama, within the jurisdiction of a Kaimmakam (lieutenant-governor) since the beginning of the 20th century.

The Ghor or Jordan valley is treated in a separate section (see **JORDAN**). There has been no systematic survey of the Ghor, but such as was carried out in Western Palestine between 1909 and 1913
